

Strike possibility at Metroland

Metroland Printing, Publishing & Distributing Ltd., the parent company of York Region Newspaper Group, including the Economist & Sun/Sun-Tribune, will be in a legal strike/lockout position at midnight Wednesday with the Communication Energy &

Paperworkers Union — Southern Ontario Newspaper Guild. The guild represents editorial employees at this and some other papers in the Metroland chain. "Talks continue on April 13 and Metroland will work toward a settlement," said company representative Brenda Biller,

vice-president of human resources. At the York Region Newspaper Group, 24 of 306 employees are represented by the guild. In the event of a strike, the newspaper will continue to publish.

Students attacked at mall

A swarm of young men pursued and attacked three other males at Pacific Mall in Milliken this week. Three young male students were at a mall arcade Wednesday at 8:30 p.m. when they noticed another group of 10 to 15 males, York Regional Police said. The males later taunted and pursued them through the Kennedy

Road shopping centre, one youth throwing a wooden pole at the fleeing trio. When the students reached their car in the underground parking lot, police said, one male jammed a metal pole into the black Honda sedan and the group threw bricks at the car as it drove off.
