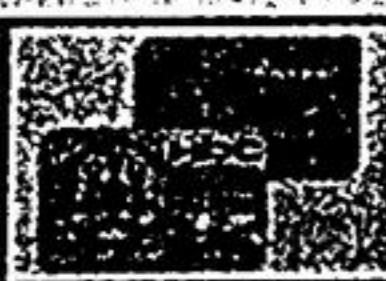

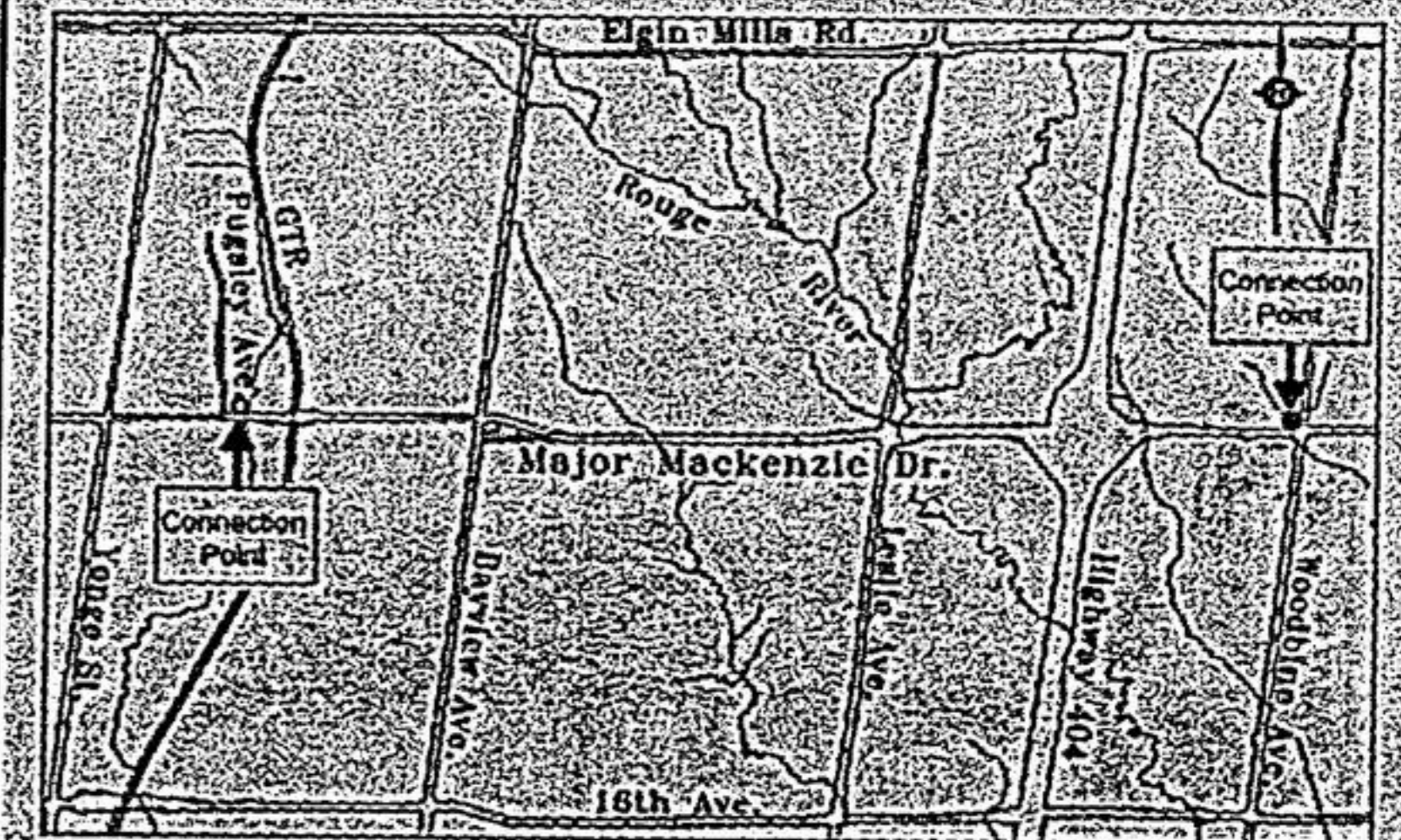

NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE

The Regional Municipality of York is undertaking a Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study to determine the preferred alignment for a new watermain along Major Mackenzie Drive, from Pugsley Avenue to Woodbine Avenue. The proposed watermain is required to reinforce the Pressure District 6 System in Richmond Hill and Markham. A preferred alignment for the watermain will be determined based on the information gathered during the study and from public and other stakeholder input. York Region has retained MacViro Consultants Inc. to complete the study.
