under suspension, driving without insurance, using a plate not authorized for a vehicle and failing to apply for a permit on becoming an owner.

"I'm still stunned alcohol was involved," Ms. Carter said outside the courtroom.

Andrew had recently befriended a 14-

year-old boy and was helping him and his father move furniture from Richmond Hill to Georgina when the driver lost control shortly after 7 p.m.

The father and son, who Ms. Carter had never met, fled the scene on foot.

They never attended Andrew's funeral in Keswick last week, nor have they contacted her. "I'm quite content with seven charges but it bothers me (police) couldn't keep him from the beginning."

OPP responded to the crash, only to find Andrew alone in the passenger's seat.

He was pronounced dead at the scene.

With the help of York Regional Police ground units and its helicopter, officers were able to detain a man and his son several hours later a short distance from the scene.

No charges were laid at the time and the driver was released.

Fatal collision investigations demand police consult with the Crown attorney's office to determine what, if any, charges will be laid, which may have accounted for the delay, OPP Const. Lisa McIntyre said.

The accused is expected to appear in court Monday.
