### NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT WARDEN AVENUE INTERSECTIONS AT MOUNT ALBERT ROAD AND AT DAVIS DRIVE

Towns of East Gwillimbury and Whitchurch-Stouffville

The Regional Municipality of York is undertaking separate Class Environmental Assessment studies for intersections along Warden Avenue at Mount Albert Road and at Davis Drive in the Towns of East Gwillimbury and Whitchurch-Stouffville. The studies have been initiated to assess the need and determine the type of improvements required at the intersections. A separate report will be prepared for each intersection.

The projects are being planned under Schedule B of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (June 2000) under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act. The public and review agencies are invited to provide input and comment for incorporation into the overall planning and design of the improvements at the Warden Avenue intersections.

A study commencement notice for the intersections was published February 12, 2002 in The Era-Banner and The Stouffville Sun. Comments received from the public and agencies at that time are on file and will be incorporated into the study.

To provide details on the study and alternatives being considered, as well as to receive input and comment from interested parties, a Public Information Centre will be held:

**Location:** Offices of the Town of East Gwillimbury, Holland Landing Room, 19000 Leslie Street, Sharon, ON

The public will have the opportunity to review and comment on the findings of the study to date, and to discuss any aspect of the study with staff from York Region and their consultants.

Comments received at this Public Information Centre will be considered in the assessment of alternatives and selection of a preferred solution.
