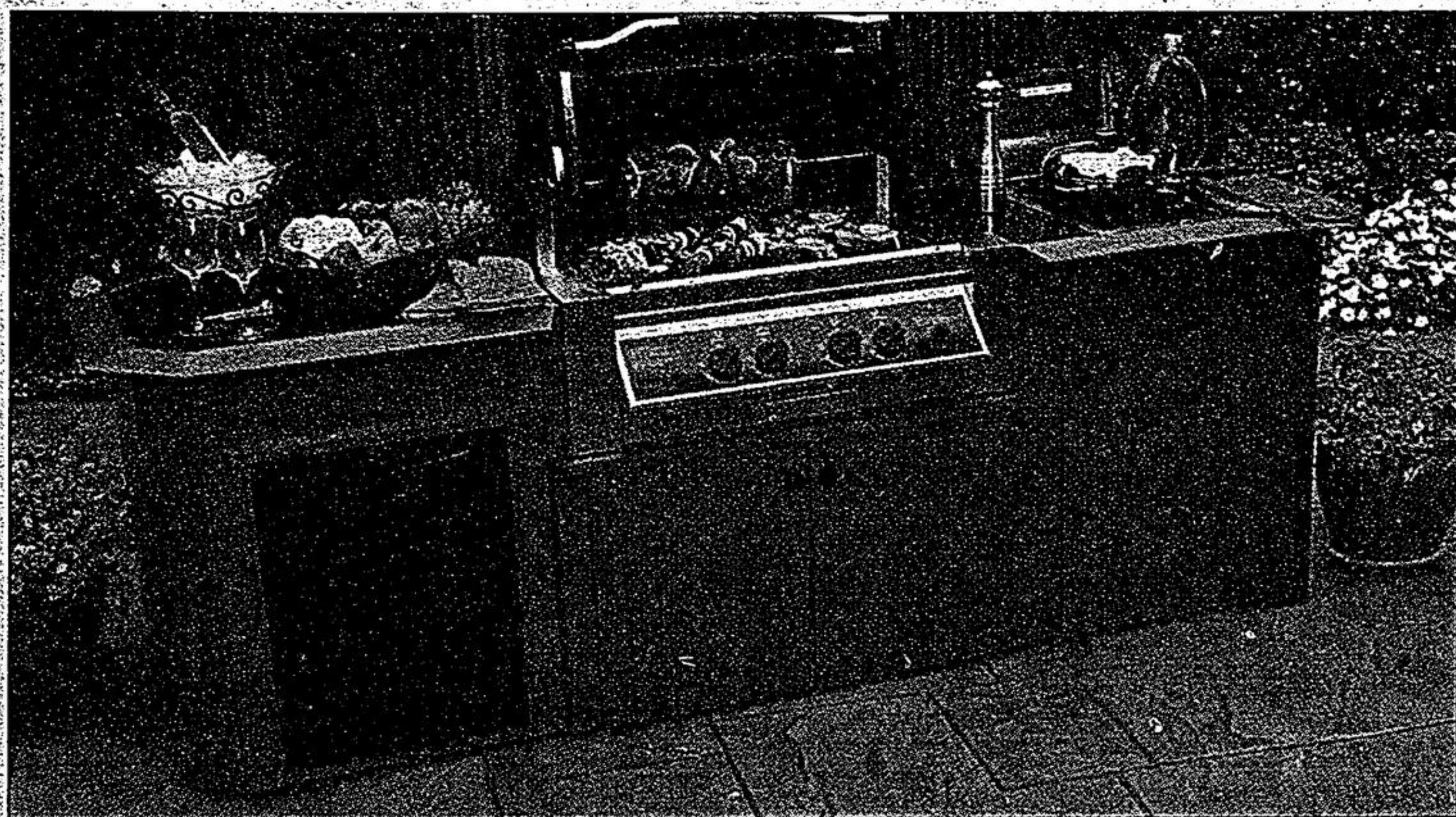

Caring for your BBQ



Now is the time to check the tank and gas hose to make sure they're in good condition. A cracked or faulty hose could be a serious problem if not caught soon enough.

(NC)-Now the weather is warming up, barbeque aficionados have started thinking about the mouth-watering tastes of food cooked on an outdoor grill. Before you fire up the grill this season you'll want to follow these suggestions on grill maintenance from the experts at one of Canada's major retail stores.

This is a good time to check the tank and gas hose to make sure they're in good condition. "A cracked or faulty hose could be a potentially serious prob-

lem if not caught soon enough," warns John DeFranco, a BBQ expert for a major retail chain. "Tanks and hoses have a tendency to rust, crack and corrode over time, so it's important that you keep an eye on them and replace them when necessary."

It's also a good idea to check the burners when tuning up your grill. A faulty or broken burner will cut the grilling capacity in half. To replace the burners, all you
