nial favourite: caesar salad with Mille Piatti's own delicious, creamy home-made dressing (\$5.95).

Next, we had to choose from 15 pastas (\$9.50+), seven pizzas (\$8.95+) and 12 entrees, including chicken, veal, lamb, steak and fish (\$11.50+).

In each section of the menu there are the traditional favourites and house specialties. Having tried several pastas, a few pizzas and almost all of the entrees, I can assure you you really can't go wrong with whatever catches your eye. Everything at Mille Piatti is prepared fresh and served with a level of care indicative of a chef-owned, family-run establishment.

Linguine tirreno (\$11.95) with smoked salmon and onions in a pink sauce is simply luscious, while the linguine al pomodoro (\$9.50) showcases just how good a properly prepared sauce can be.

The pizzas offer thin crusts and an abundance of fresh toppings from goat cheese and roasted red peppers to portobello mushrooms and Italian sausage. A pizza also makes a perfect appetizer for three or four to share.

For our entrees, my dining companions and I selected vitello piccata (\$12.50) that offered large, tender pieces of veal delicately bathed in a lemon wine sauce and pollo parmigiana — traditional chicken parmesan, large, hearty and smothered in sauce and cheese. All entrees are served with crisp roasted potatoes and delicately steamed sea-

sonal vegetables. The desserts vary daily and most are brought in. The tiramisu, however, is premise prepared and, if available, try to get a piece put aside for you. It's worth it.
