Candidates trade jabs on immigration

said Mr. Li, an immigrant who founded a club for fellow Indian-born Chinese and said he often persuades employers to hire new Canadians whether or not they have Canadian experience.

"Any hardworking immigrants who come to this country, they are more than welcome," Mr. Li said.

Mr. McCallum said Mr. Harper's comment is "far more insulting to new Canadians than Joe Li's".

Facing a challenge in a riding where immigrants form a majority, Mr. McCallum argued the Liberals are a party that celebrates multiculturalism, but the Tories do not. "At best, the Conservatives tolerate new Canadians. New Canadians understand that."

A Liberal website, stephen-harpersaid.ca features the

Harper quote, which the future Tory leader gave The Report, a regional newsmagazine in 2001 when he was still president of the National Citizens' Coalition lobby group.

"You've got to remember," Mr. Harper said, "that west of Winnipeg the ridings the Liberals hold are dominated by people who are either recent Asian immigrants or recent migrants from Eastern Canada: people who live in ghettos and who are not integrated into Western Canadian society."

A scornful Mr. Karygiannis called attention to the quote Wednesday before telling his audience he is proud to represent "a ghetto", implying that's what Mr. Harper would call his riding because of its large number of Asian-Canadian residents.

Charles Bird, a communications worker in the Liberal's Toronto headquarters said while there is no deliberate strategy to encourage candidates to use the "ghettos" quote, candidates know of the website so their use of it is not surprising.
