Tanaka invited to audition for provincial under-17 hockey team

Cory Tanaka was among 84 minor hockey prospects from across the province selected to take part in the Ontario Under-17 Program Provincial Camp at York University Aug. 13 to 15.

A 15-year-old Stouffville resident who recently completed Grade 10 at Stouffville District Secondary School, Tanaka was chosen to take part in this year's camp, which will serve to help identify 22 players for the Ontario squad at the 2005 World Under-17 Hockey Challenge in Lethbridge, Alta. from Dec. 29 to Jan. 4.

The goal of the provincial camp is to provide the players with a competitive, high-calibre training opportunity.

"The process of evaluating the 84 players selected to attend this year's camp will be a real challenge, as this is a very talented group of athletes," Mike Futa, under-17 program director of operations, said.

Coaching the team will be James Boyd, Jason Brooks and Marty Williamson, who was the head coach this past season of the national champion Aurora Tigers of the Provincial Junior A Hockey League.

The 84 players were chosen at various regional camps held throughout the province during April and May. More than 1,200 players attended the regional talent identification camps.
