

Gibbons races to third place

Peter Gibbons drove his Canadian Tire/Monroe Brakes Chevrolet to a third-place finish in the CASCAR Atto Canada Day Shoot Out at Cayuga Speedway near Hamilton.

The 41-year-old Stouffville resident began the 200-lap race from the third position and took over the lead on lap 39. He eventually lapped all but two cars on the 5/8 oval track.

But on a late race caution on lap 185, Gibbons and the other top runners opted to pit.

All hopes of winning the race ended there when Gibbons' crew changed two tires when they were only allowed to do one at that point of the race.

As a result, Gibbons was assessed a stop-and-go penalty. With only a handful of laps remaining, Gibbons handed over the win to Dave Whitlock.

Gibbons maintains a 25-point lead over Whitlock in the overall CASCAR series standings through five races.

Sixth straight golf win for Gajan
