The purpose of the Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2001 (ODA) is to improve opportunities for people with disabilities and to provide for their involvement in the identification, removal and prevention of barriers to their full participation in the life of the province. The ODA mandates that all municipalities prepare annual accessibility plans. In the 2005 Annual Accessibility Plan, the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville aims to describe barrier removal initiatives accomplished in 2004 and outline measures to be taken in 2005 to identify, remove and prevent barriers to people with disabilities.

**2004 COMMERCIAL, INDUSTRIAL & MULTI-RESIDENTIAL FINAL TAX INSTALLMENT**

2nd Installment Due - November 19, 2004

THE PENALTY charged for non-payment of 2004 taxes is one and one-quarter (1 1/4) percent imposed on the first day of default and on the first day of each month thereafter.

FAILURE TO receive a tax bill does not eliminate the responsibility for payment of taxes nor the penalty charges for late payment.

TAX PAYMENTS may be made by mail, or in person at the Town Office and at most Financial Institutions through tellers, banking machines and by telephone. Banking fees may apply. Penalty will be charged and added to your tax account at our office, on payments made at the bank after the due dates. After hours tax payments may be left in the drop box at the front west entrance door of the Imperial Building (37 Sandiford Drive).

VACANCY REBATE APPLICATIONS are available at the Town offices during business hours, for any commercial or industrial properties that have been vacant for 90 consecutive days. The deadline for submitting the application for the 2004 taxation year is February 28, 2005.

**PURPOSE & EFFECT**

The Community of Stouffville Secondary Plan (Official Plan Amendment No. 101) was adopted by Town Council on October 14th, 1997 and was approved by the Ontario Municipal Board on September 18th, 1998. The Planning Act under the authority of Section 26 requires a municipality to review its Official Plan/Secondary Plan documents not less frequently than every five years, and to solicit comments from the public in respect of the need for a revision to the Plan to ensure that it continues to respond to the dynamics and expectations of the community.

The information gathered at this meeting will be used to prepare Terms of Reference to re-evaluate the policy framework in the Secondary Plan or amend the Plan if this is deemed to be necessary.

**YARD WASTE/LEAF COLLECTION**

**PUBLIC NOTICE**

Residents are advised that leaves will only be collected if they are in paper bags, reusable open top containers (excluding cardboard boxes) such as bushel baskets or garbage cans or clear plastic bags.

The Town does not pick up leaves raked, blown or piled along the roads. Non-containerized or non-bagged leaves present a traffic and drainage hazard and residents are required to remove them.

Yard Waste should be placed curbside for collection by 7:00 am on the collection day.
