**TOWN HALL MEETING REDEVELOPMENT OF 19 CIVIC AVENUE (OLD TOWN HALL)**

The Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville has retained the services of The Ventin Group Architects to develop a Concept and Business Plan for the Redevelopment of the Municipal Building (Old Town Hall) at 19 Civic Avenue.

The focus of this study is to explore the establishment of a Cultural and Arts Centre within the historically designated 19 Civic Avenue building.

The Consultant will present an overview of the project findings to date and solicit public input for inclusion in the final report.
