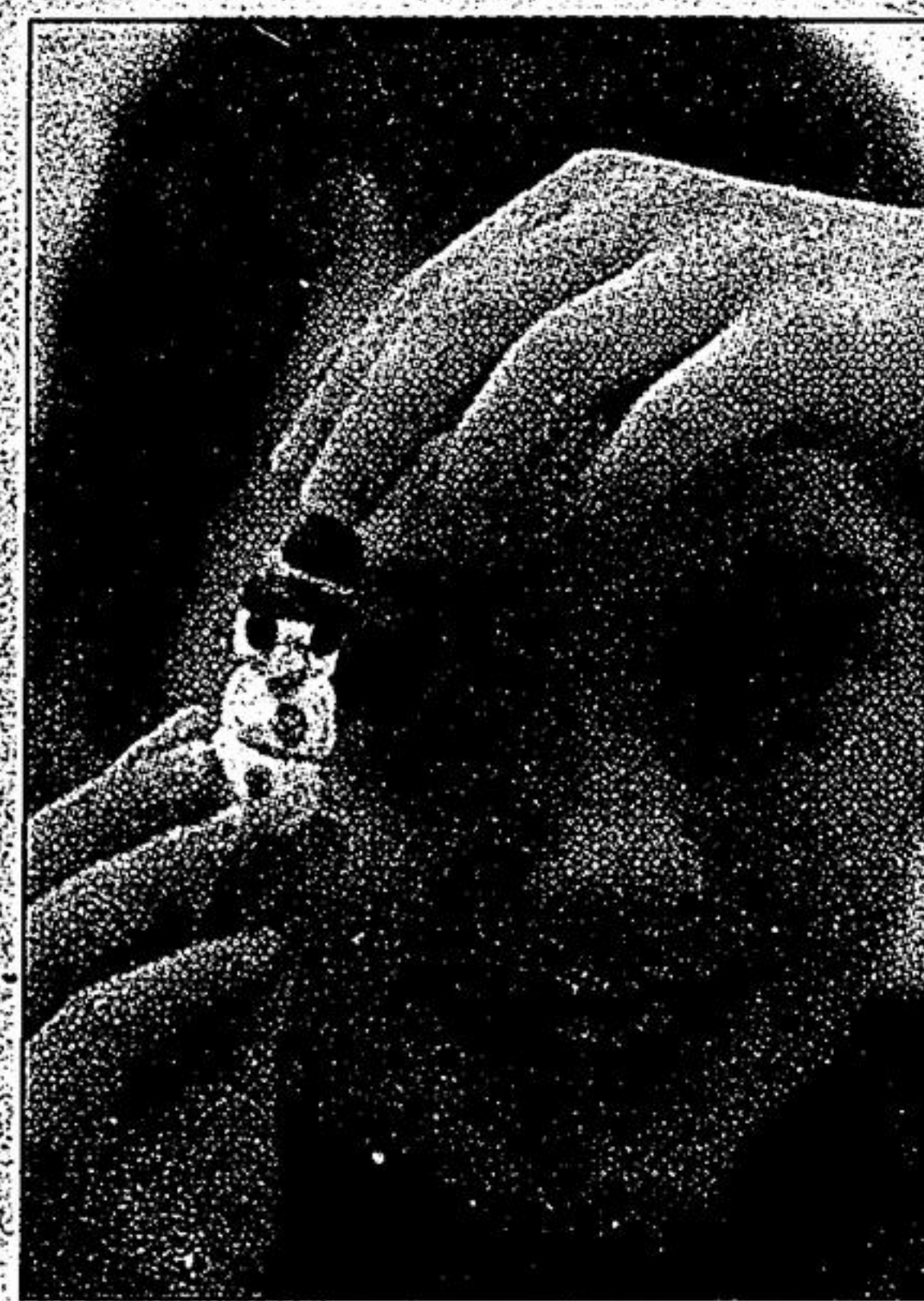


I will try to help more around the house. I would like to get a hamster. I am going to try to look after him all by myself.
