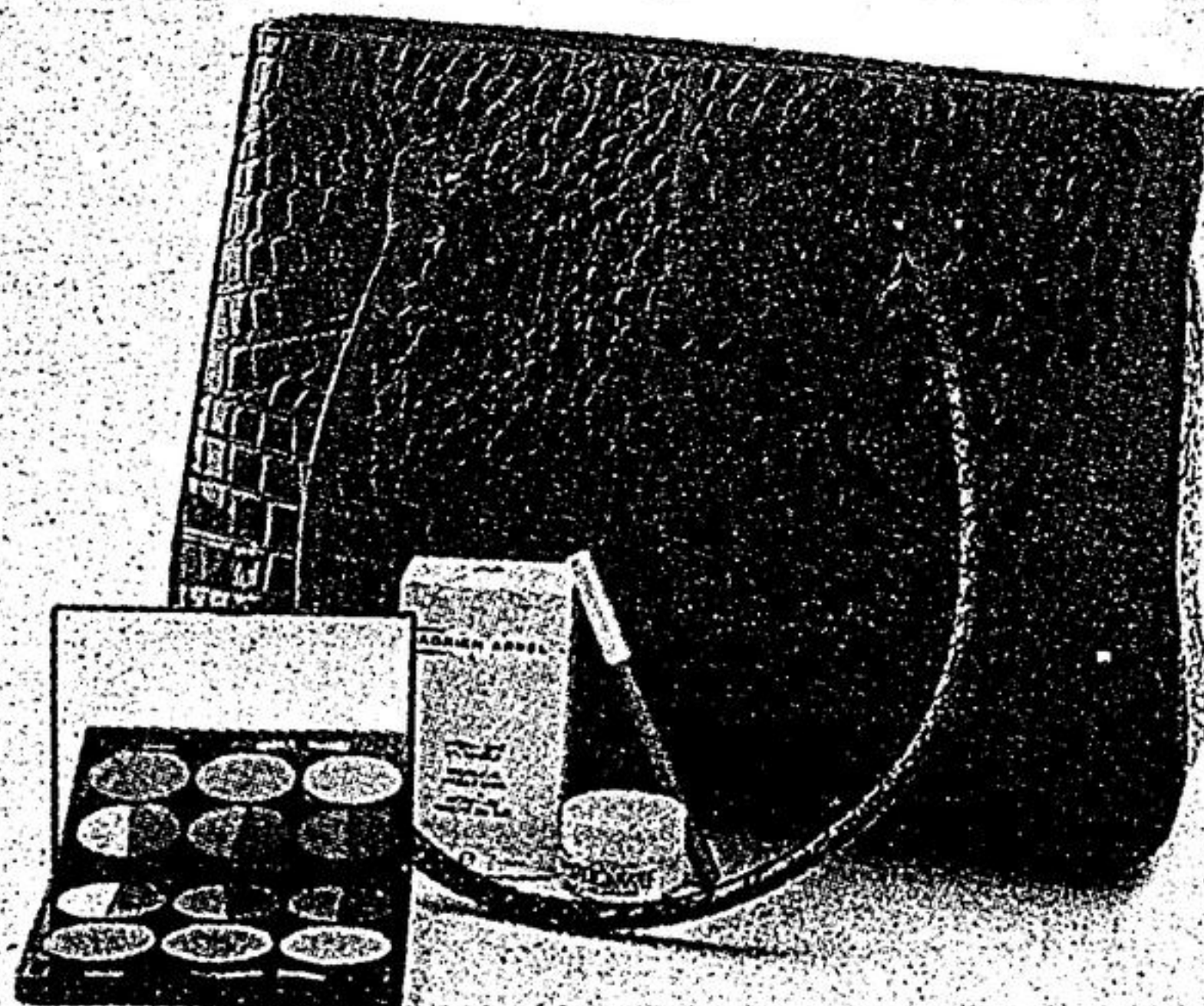

## 2 arrested in vicious robbery spree

York Regional Police have arrested two men and issued a warrant for a third in connection with a violent armed crime spree at Chinese restaurants and massage parlours last year.

"This is about as bad as it gets for armed robberies. It's the most invasive type of robbery we have," Det. -Sgt. Fred Moffatt said of the 17 robberies in York Region and Toronto.

The Mr. Bean Eatery in Richmond Hill and the Golden Wok and Dragon Boat restaurants in Markham were robbed between April 30 and May 26 by a group of armed men who stormed through the back door, forcing employees and patrons to the floor and robbing each.

"In some cases, people were beaten and pistol whipped," Det.-Sgt. Moffatt added.

In one day, two Vaughan

body rub parlours and a Richmond Hill Chinese eatery were robbed.

"They were on quite a roll throughout York Region and Toronto," Det.-Sgt. Moffatt said.

One suspect was arrested Wednesday, a second Thursday and police were issuing a warrant for a third Friday.

All three men are from Peel Region and are facing 89 robbery and weapons charges each.

There may be more arrests as the investigation continues, Det.-Sgt. Moffatt said.

Some witnesses said there may have been up to five or six people involved, he said.

Given the nature of the some of the body rub businesses robbed, there may have been more victims.

Police are asking anyone who was robbed to come forward.
