potential loss of property values.

Hydro One's withdrawal allows the newly appointed Ontario Power Authority to investigate all options — transmission lines or gas-fired generation — for the region's growing electricity problem.

A study done by area utility companies last spring revealed consumption was growing by more than 6 per cent a year, enough to cause blackouts or brownouts by the winter of 2007.

While the Northland project will not meet northern York Region's total additional hydro requirements, experts say it will delay the need for transmission lines for up to 10 years.

Mr. Mantenuto said Northland's project could be up and running within two years of approvals being received.

Whatever the Ontario Power Authority decides, a decision is needed quickly, according to Paul Ferguson,

general manager of Newmarket Hydro.

"Growth is still occurring and electricity demand is still increasing," Mr. Ferguson said.

"I'm sure the (power authority) is conscious of that and will try and conduct its review in a timely manner."

The region's hydro situation will get top priority, according to Jan Carr, CEO of the power authority.

"We're just getting our resources lined up; we're a pretty new organization, but this is a high priority," Mr. Carr said.

And even with Hydro One's withdrawal, the 24-kilometre-long hydro line might be the option chosen by the power authority, according to Oak Ridges Tory MPP Frank Klees.

"We must remain vigilant to ensure the Hydro One proposal doesn't become the proposal of choice," Mr. Klees said. "No one should be fooled into believing the fight is won. This is an interim measure so that alternative proposals can be assessed."
