

# New CEO ready to take library into future

As Whitchurch-Stouffville Public Library's new CEO and secretary/treasurer, Carolyn Nordheimer James has taken on the job of steering the library into a future of unprecedented growth in the community.

She replaces Marilyn Ferguson, who retired after 33 years at the library.

Coping with expansion of services has been made easier because of Ms Ferguson's planning, Ms Nordheimer James said, noting "lots of technology is already there".

Although technology will continue to advance, people will still use the library to borrow books and other materials. People look on a library as a retreat where they can sit and study, open a book or check out newspapers, she said.

changes in their lives," she said.

Before she found her "true calling" in library work, Ms Nordheimer James taught high school French, English and history in Montreal. She decided to go for a masters degree in library science after working part time at the Brampton Public Library.

While her five children were young, she taught continuing education courses at Mohawk College in Hamilton.

Most recently, Ms Nordheimer James was public services co-ordinator for the Ft. Erie Public Library,

where she co-ordinated an automation upgrade and a moved a branch into a multi-use facility shared with the municipality.

Before she takes on her new duties May 9, she and her husband, Brian, are moving from Ft. Erie.

They're hoping to live as close to the Whitchurch-Stouffville area as possible.

Ms Nordheimer James found Stouffville to be a close-knit community that embodies the town slogan of Country Close to the City.

She believes growth must be carefully planned, noting "You don't want to lose that country feeling".

Ms Nordheimer James is looking forward to exploring local walking and biking trails.

In Ft. Erie, she was on the board of a non-profit organization providing walking and biking facilities in the Niagara region.

She often rode her bicycle to work.

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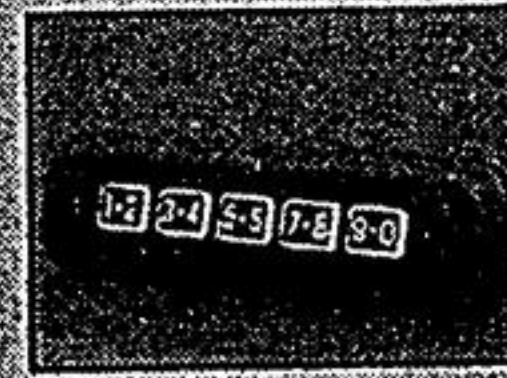
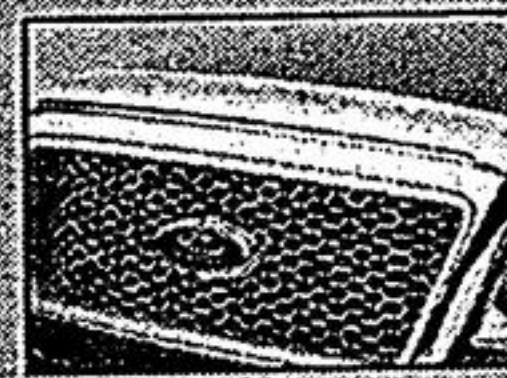
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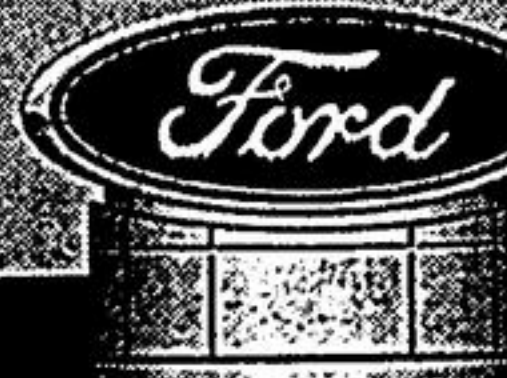
