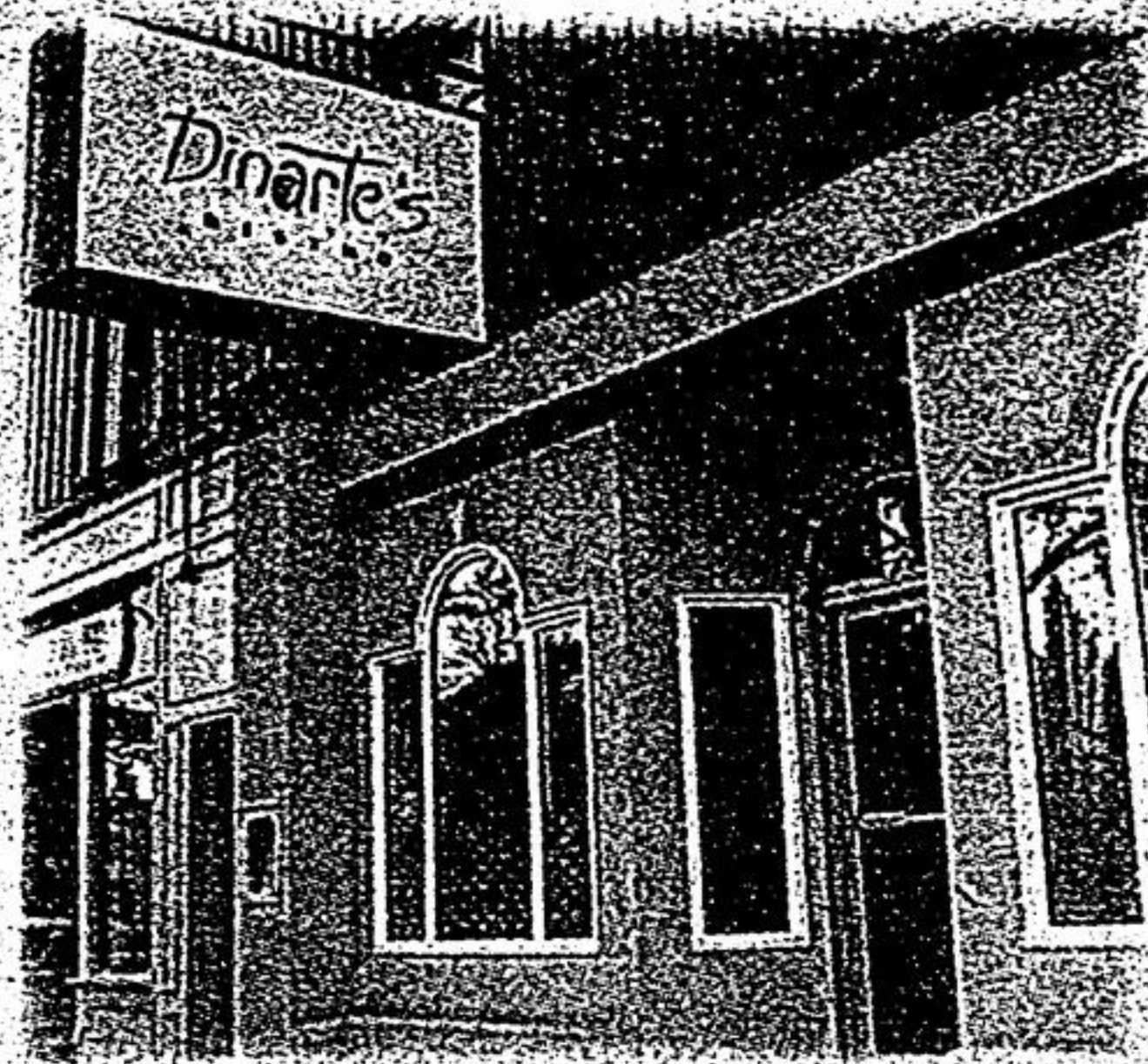

Youth charged in stabbing

A 17-year-old youth was stabbed at a gas station across the road from a Markham high school Thursday.

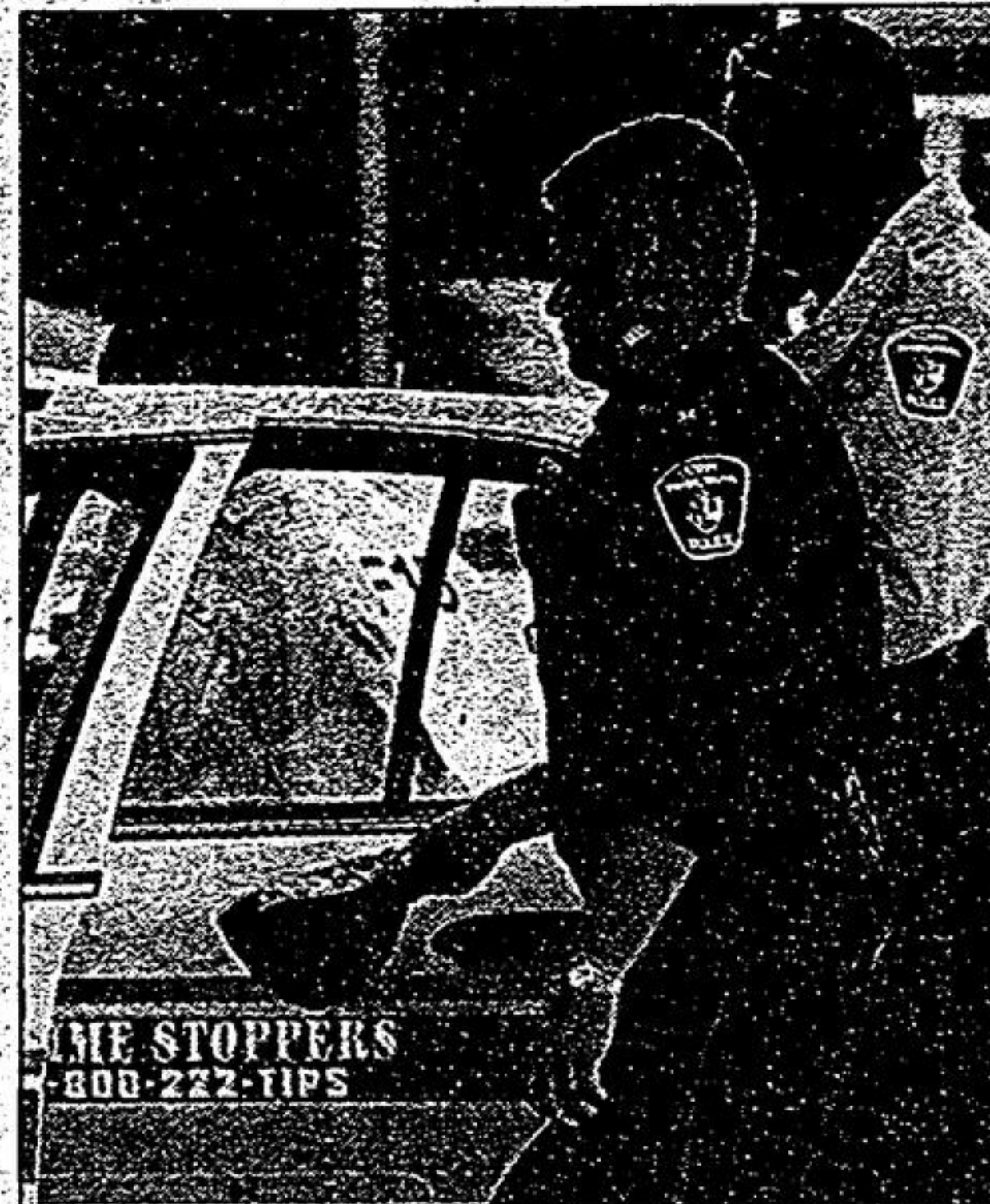
Several York Regional Police cars rushed to a fight at a Sunoco station opposite Father Michael McGivney Catholic Academy at McCowan Road and 14th Avenue just before 3 p.m.

The fight broke out as school let out, said Joseph Seliah, a gas station attendant who saw the stabbing. A Markham youth was treated for minor wounds to his back and released from hospital.

With tears in his eyes, a McGivney student, who wouldn't provide his name, said a number of boys tried to beat up a friend of his when someone stabbed another boy in the back.

A 16-year-old Markham youth was arrested on aggravated assault charges.
