## Stats off to our Volunteers!



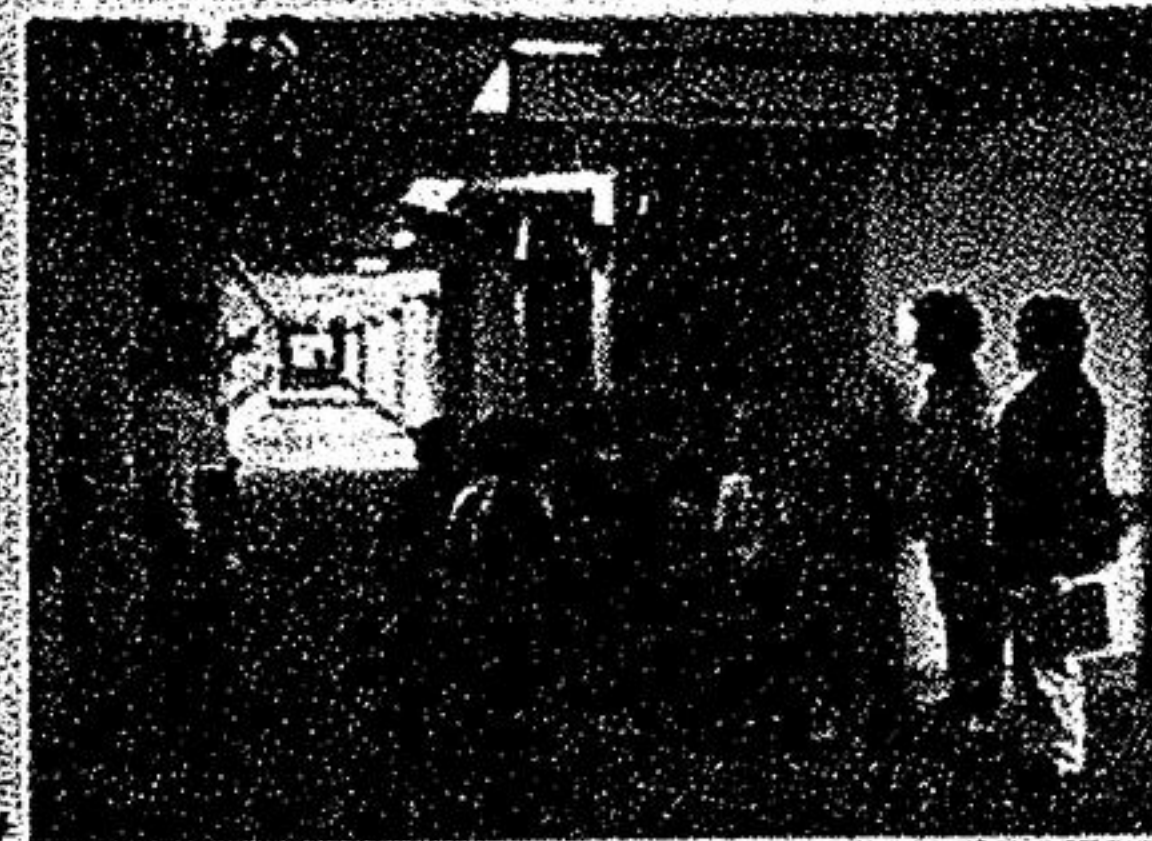
