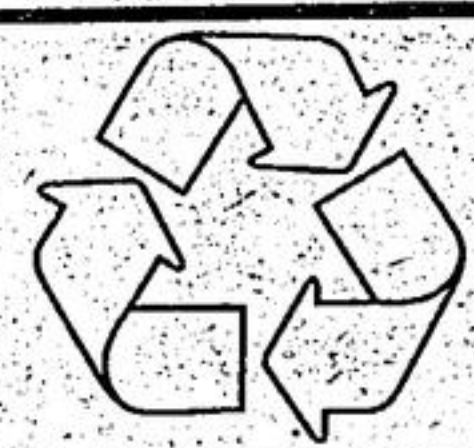

UPBEAT HIRING CLIMATE EXPECTED FOR YORK REGION

York Region area employers expect a favourable hiring pace for the second quarter of 2005, according to the latest Manpower Employment Outlook Survey.

Survey data shows that 20 per cent of employers plan to hire for the upcoming quarter (April to June), while three per cent plan to reduce their workforce, stated Kiren Bhogal of Manpower's Newmarket office. Another 77 per cent of the city's employers expect to maintain their current staffing levels.

"York Region's second quarter Net Employment Outlook of 17 per cent is a significant decrease from the same time last year when the Net Employment Outlook was 40 per cent," said Bhogal. "However, it is a

positive increase from the previous three months when the Net Employment Outlook was seven per cent, indicating a hopeful hiring climate in York Region."

Nationally, employers in the Construction and Finance, Insurance & Real Estate sectors expect the healthiest results for the April to June 2005 period. Both sectors have a projected Net Employment Outlook of 24 per cent once seasonal variations are removed.

"The Net Employment Outlooks for the first two quarters of 2005 are stronger than all Net Employment Outlooks reported in 2004, once seasonal variations are removed," said Deborah Bakti, spokesperson for Manpower Canada.
