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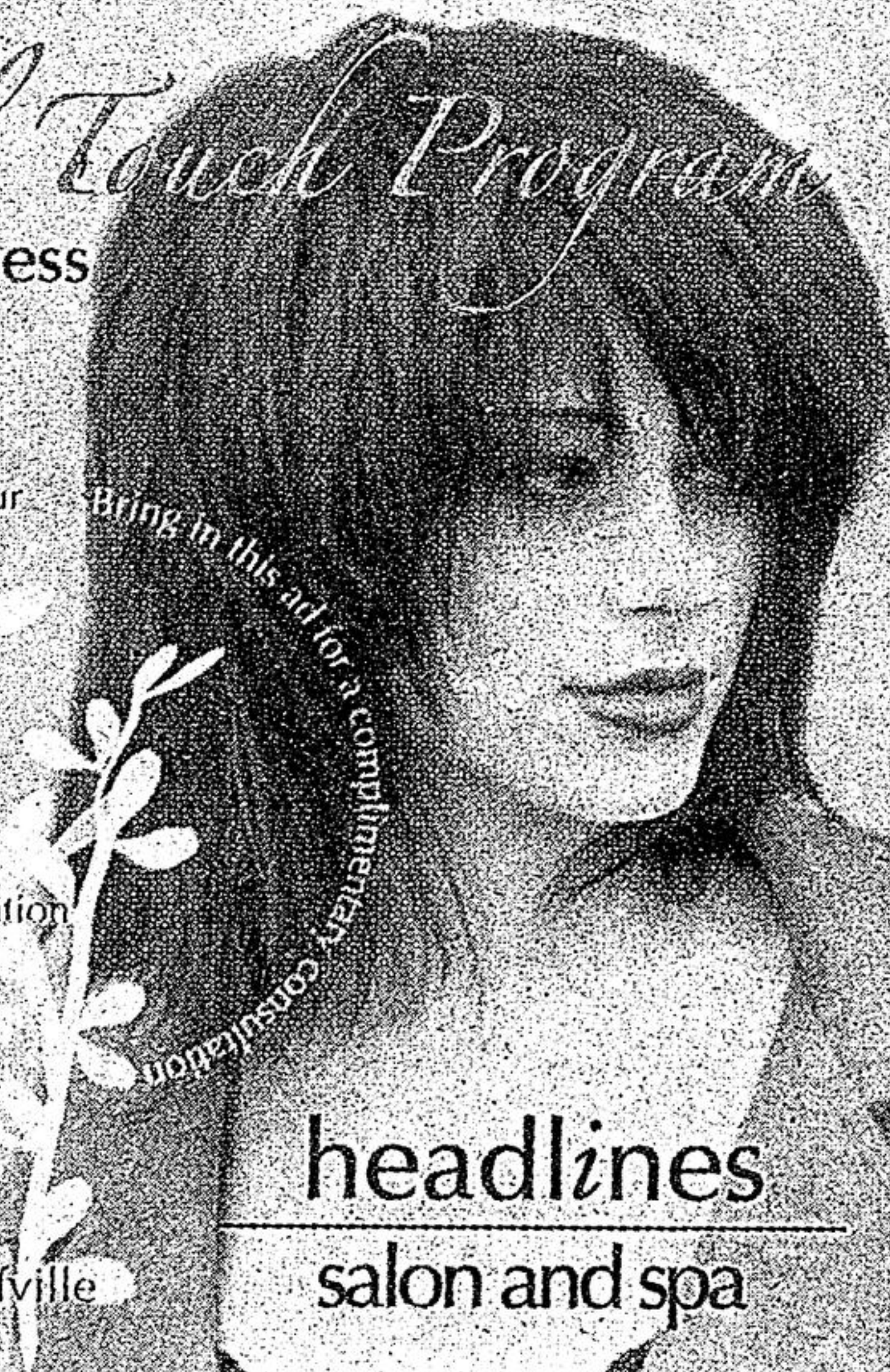

Amendment to the Residential Seven (R7) Zone General Zoning By-law 87-34 File No. ZBA05.010

NOTICE OF MEETING
TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville will hold a Public Meeting on Tuesday May 31st, 2005 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers, Town Municipal Offices, 37 Sandiford Drive, 4th Floor, under the authority of Section 34 of the Planning Act

PURPOSE & EFFECT
The purpose of the Public Meeting is to solicit comments from interested members of the community and public agencies of the provisions of the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment. The Amendment contemplates revising the regulatory provisions of the Residential Seven (R7) Zone classification as it relates to the Interior Yard Setback. The proposed Amendment would permit (R7) zoned residential lots that have a Lot Frontage of 11 metres or wider to be eligible for consideration for a reduced Interior Yard Setback. If deemed to be eligible, the Interior Side Yard for one side of the property could be reduced to 0.6 metres from the present 1.2 metre standard if certain building design and site engineering matters are addressed to the satisfaction of the Town.

The proposed Amendment would apply to all lands zoned Residential Seven (R7) within the Municipality as established in General Zoning By-law 87-34.

RELATED APPLICATION
There are no related applications.

REPRESENTATION
ANY PERSON may attend the Public Meeting and make written or oral submissions either in support of or in opposition to the proposed Zoning By-law Amendment. If you are unable to attend, written submissions will be received up to the time of the meeting. APPEAL
If a person or public body that files an appeal of a decision of the Council of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville in respect of the proposed Zoning By-law does not make oral submissions at a Public Meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville before the proposed Zoning By-law is adopted, the Ontario Municipal Board may dismiss all or part of the appeal.
