Big Bike a go for Main Street run

It was touch and go for a while, but The Big Bike for Heart and Stroke will ride down Stouffville's Main Street after all Saturday.

It will start from the town offices at Main Street and Sandiford Drive at 11 a.m. and head to the Giant Tiger plaza. The bike will go up and down that stretch of Main Street for about a half hour.

Since only one local business, Curves for Women fitness studio on Main Street, was able to form a team for the ride, it

was not certain the ride could even proceed. But in the end, the decision was made to bring the Big Bike to Stouffville on June 4 for the 29-member team. Team members have been collecting pledges to benefit the Heart and Stroke Foundation.

There was interest in the ride, Rebecca Robertson, the area co-ordinator for the Heart and Stroke Foundation, said, but local businesses and other organizations weren't able to get enough people together for teams.

This is the third annual big bike fundraiser in Stouffville.

Last year, Curves raised more than \$6,000 of the \$9,000 donated to the foundation by the four teams participating in the ride, Ms Robertson said.

It takes a minimum of \$3,000 in pledges to bring the bike to town.

For future rides, two or three smaller teams could share a bike ride.
