Castle takes second in CJGA event

The 16-year-old Stouffville resident carded a 10-over par

82 on the first day and an 81 on the second day.

In the same division, Matthew Easter of Stouffville finished in a two-way tie for 36th place.

Easter, 15, carded a two-round 181 (89-92).

Adam Petrasovic, 16, of Tecumseh, won the division with a 149 (74-75).

Three-game spin halted by Mennos

The Stouffville Mennos snapped a three-game losing streak Monday with a resounding 9-0 road win over the Markham Majors in Oshawa City and District Fastball League action at Centennial Park in Markham.

The tone of the game was set in the first inning when Scott Eyre and Jeff Boadway singled. Combined with two Majors' errors, a walk, wild pitch and a hit batsmen, the Mennos erupted for four runs and never looked back.

The Mennos added a run in the second inning on a four-base error by a Majors' outfielder.

The Mennos rounded out the scoring with a run in the fourth and three in the fifth, buoyed by a triple from Shawn Boadway.

Terry Reesor tossed three innings of relief for Baranieski, who started the game, and absorbed the loss.

The two losses came on the heels of an 8-4 loss to the visiting Bradford Sox May 19.

The Mennos scored twice in the first and added single runs in the sixth on a solo homer by Rob Reesor, and once in the seventh inning.

Baranieski worked the first five innings and surrendered six runs off eight hits to take the loss for the Mennos.

Now 2-4-1 in league play, the Mennos return to the diamond tonight when they are scheduled to host Newmarket at Memorial Park starting at 8:45 p.m.
