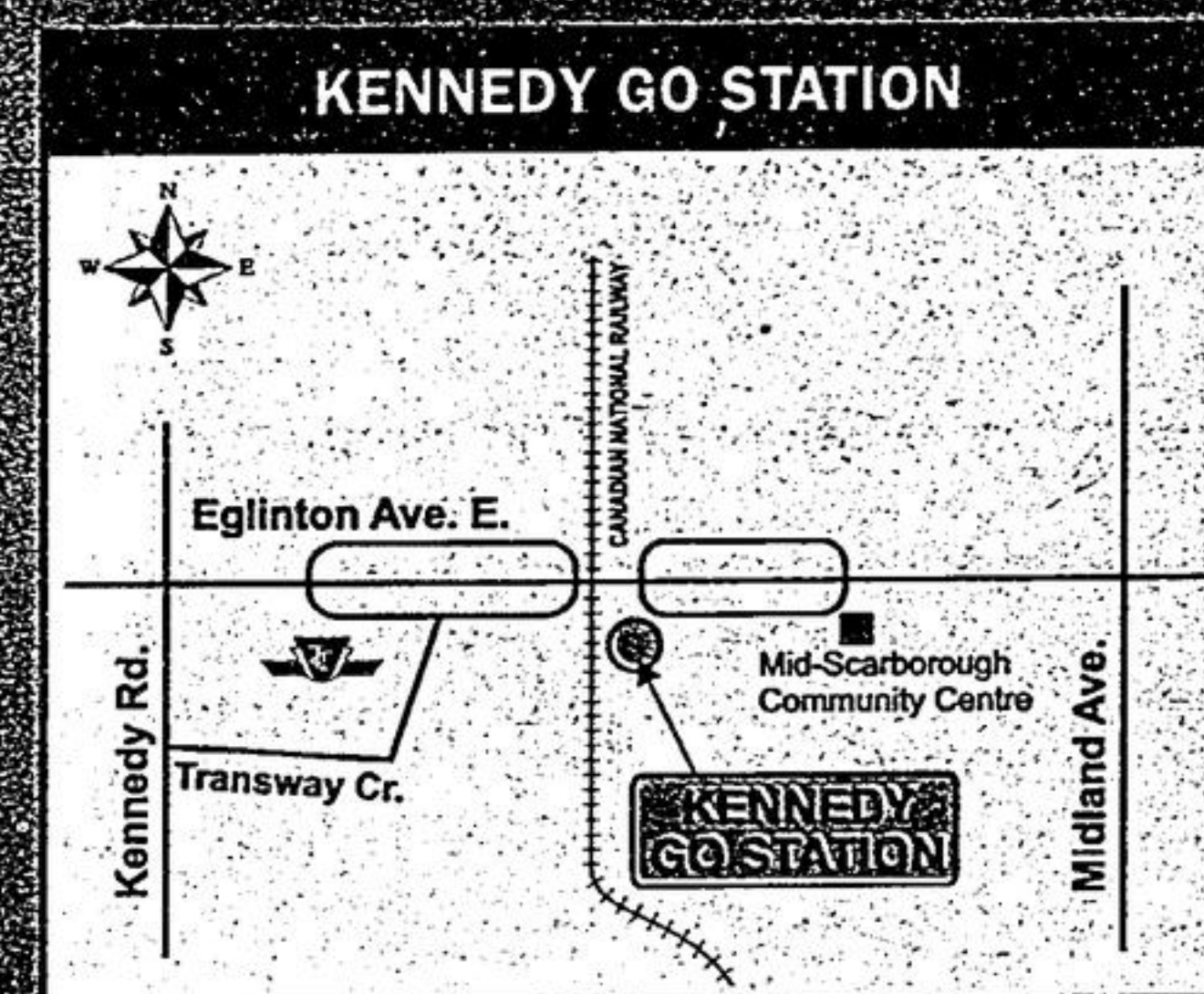
## ANNOUNCING OUR NEW KENNEDY GO STATION WITH CONNECTIONS TO THE TTC.
