NOTICE OF COMPLETION NEIGHBOURHOOD TRAFFIC CALMING
In the area bounded by Sandale Road, Ninth Line, Main Street and Elm Road

Glad Park Avenue	- Full closure between the two intersections with Elm Road
Fairview Avenue	- Full closure at north limit of commercial properties fronting on Main Street; and Southbound obstruction at Elm Road
West Lawn Crescent	- Pavement narrowing between Glad Park Avenue and Rupert Avenue to create a west side on street parking area
Rupert Avenue	- Eastbound obstruction immediately east of Winona Drive
Ninth Line	- Prohibit southbound right turns at Rupert Avenue from 7am to 9am Monday to Friday and Saturday 9am to 2pm

The above traffic calming projects are being planned under Schedule B of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Act. Interested persons should provide written comment to the municipality on the proposal within 30 calendar days from the date of this Notice. Comments on the projects should be directed to Paul Whitehouse, Director of Public Works, Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville, 37 Sandiford Drive, 4th Floor Stouffville ON L4A 7X5.

If concerns arise regarding these projects, which cannot be resolved in discussion with the municipality, a person or party may request that the Minister of the Environment make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred as a Part II Order), which addresses individual environmental assessments. Requests must be received by the Minister at the address below within 30 calendar days of this Notice. A copy of the request must also be sent to the Director of Public Works. If there is no request received by Monday August 15th, 2005, the traffic calming measures may proceed to design and construction. Construction is subject to budget availability and relative priority.

STRATEGIC PLAN OF ACTION FOR DOWNTOWN STOUFFVILLE APPOINTMENT TO THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville Clerk's Department is now accepting applications for appointments to an Advisory Committee that will be preparing a Strategic Plan of Action for Downtown Stouffville for Council's consideration.

Appointments are being considered from the following community members:

- 3 representatives of the public-at-large;
- 2 youth representatives; and,
- 3 landowners of properties within the Core Area of Stouffville.

There is no remuneration associated with this appointment, and the term of the appointment expires on November 1st, 2005 with the submission of the Final Draft Report to Town Council.

Duties and Functions:

The Advisory Committee's goal is to prepare an organized, long term and co-ordinated plan involving the public and private sectors designed to advance downtown improvement and the facilitation of investment / reinvestment within this historic commercial district.

The community members referenced above along with members from the Business Improvement Association, the Chamber of Commerce, the Town's Economic Development Advisory Committee, members of Town Council, and the Whitchurch-Stouffville Heritage Advisory Committee are going to complete the following tasks:

- Participate in a design charette (workshop) on Friday September 9th and Saturday September 10th with the assistance of Town Staff and a consultant, and a follow-up meeting scheduled for the week of October 17th;
- Identify a vision statement for the Core Area of Stouffville;
- Identify the strengths and weaknesses of the Core Area;
- Prepare a listing of priorities of projects to be completed over the short to long term period that are designed to respond to the Goal and the vision statement;
- With the assistance of the consultant and Town Staff, to prepare a Draft Final Report for submission to Town Council which will be in the form of a Strategic Plan of Action.

RECYCLING REMINDERS

- food and beverage containers identified with the numbers 1-7 in the recycling triangle are now accepted. Acceptable containers must have a recycling code number on the container (no clear molded plastic packaging);
- all food and beverage containers must be rinsed and the lids removed
- foil sheets should be rolled into balls no smaller than 7 cm (3 inches) in diameter. Foil trays should be folded down to a size no larger than 30 cm wide and 30 cm long (12 x 12 inches)
- paint cans and aerosol containers must be EMPTIED and dry and lids removed from the cans
- garbage & recycling that is placed in cardboard boxes **WILL NOT** be collected. Cardboard is recyclable.
- cardboard boxes that are placed out for recycling collection should be flattened and tied in 2' x 2' x 1' bundles.
