Tips to maintain your furnace

obstructions away from the-furnace area.

- Keep cold air returns and heat distribution vents free and clear of obstructions to allow proper air flow.

- Ensure an adequate supply of combustion air is available for the appliance to function properly. Combustion air mixes

with fuel to allow combustion to occur inside the furnace.

- Hire a professional to clean the ducting once every three to five years.

- Contact a licensed/qualified heating contractor each year to perform routine service and maintenance according to the manufacturer's specifications.


In addition, consider replacing your forced-air gas furnace with a high efficiency model.

For every one dollar that is spent on gas for a conventional forced-air gas furnace, approximately 30 cents goes up the chimney, while every dollar that is spent on gas for a high efficiency furnace results in the loss of 10 cents or less.

Upgrading to a high-efficiency furnace can generate substantial cost savings. A heating contractor or your local AmeriSpec home inspector can help decide whether an upgrade is a worthwhile investment.
