"She was a great person," Zach said about his mom. "She was a great person to have around."

Mrs. Barr and her sister saw Terry Fox as he passed through Peterborough on his famous run, but at the time they didn't realize the enduring significance of his Marathon of Hope.

The Terry Fox Foundation receives so much support from people, Zach said, because "he had a dream. He was dedicated to raising money for cancer research."

Zach has designed T-shirts and water bottle logos for the Team Amanda members. The front of the shirt says, "Run for Nun", short for Amanda's nickname Nunny. The back sports the words Team Amanda.

The team has collected about \$2,500 in pledges.

Zach would like to see Team Amanda take part in Terry Fox Runs every year.

Registration for the Terry Fox Run starts at noon Sunday at the Stouffville Arena. There are 5 and 10-kilometre routes this year.
