# 39 wells replaced in region

sewer as clean water and goes through the treatment plant and is released as clean water (into Lake Ontario).

"The rest goes into the streams; we don't want to put too much into the streams both from a flow and temperature point of view."

The region also issued a media release highlighting its \$30-million environmental

monitoring and mitigation program, including \$7 million for residents who have experienced problems with private wells.

Since the 16th Avenue trunk sewer began, the region has received calls from more than 475 residents and concluded:

- 146 households were not affected by construction;
- 144 called for information;
- 68 homes had their wells modified;
- 47 households had problems unrelated to the construc-

tion;

• 39 have had their wells replaced;

• 21 were provided with temporary water tanks until well levels recovered and;

• 11 have been hooked up to municipal water systems.

The project is constantly monitored by the Environment Ministry, the federal Department of Fisheries and Oceans and the conservation authority, Mr. Araniysundaran said.


