WATER DISTRIBUTION FLUSHING PROGRAM

COMMUNITIES OF BALLANTRAE & MUSSELMAN LAKE

The Public Works Department reminds residents that it is conducting routine flushing operations of the Ballantrae/Musselman Lake municipal water distribution system.

The next flushing of the system is scheduled to resume on Monday October 24th, 2005 and will be conducted between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., and will be repeated every four (4) weeks until further notice.

This flushing is necessary to simulate normal operation of the system.

COMMUNITY OF STOUFFVILLE

The Public Works Department will be conducting a watermain flushing program throughout the Community of Stouffville, commencing Monday October 24th, 2005. This work will be conducted between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. and is expected to last until approximately Friday November 14th, 2005.

During the flushing operation discoloration of the water may occur and because of this we ask for your assistance by restricting the use of water to a minimum while the work is being conducted. Should discoloration of the water occur after the work has been completed let water run until it clears.
