

'Kill or feed' Latcham Gallery, chairperson tells town

Randy Mole, an unsuccessful mayoralty candidate in 2003, recommended the proposed complex be an issue during next fall's municipal election campaign.

On complaints of gallery underfunding, Mr. Button urged the town to either "kill it or feed it." The gallery's 2005 budget was \$150,000, including \$65,000 from a provincial grant.

Many in attendance want the municipality to assume a greater cultural role, but more as a provider than a facilitator.

"We don't want the municipality to initiate events," said Mr. Button. "Private enterprise does it better."

Stouffville resident Pam Mandich

urged a closer working relationship between the town and York Region's public school board.

"Let's make the schools an important part of this venture," she said, "This is where the children are."

John Roberts, a professional artist and former teacher at Stouffville District Secondary School, said the gallery is very involved with students, but the program could be expanded.

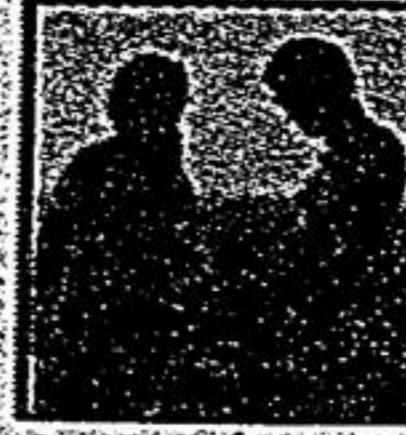

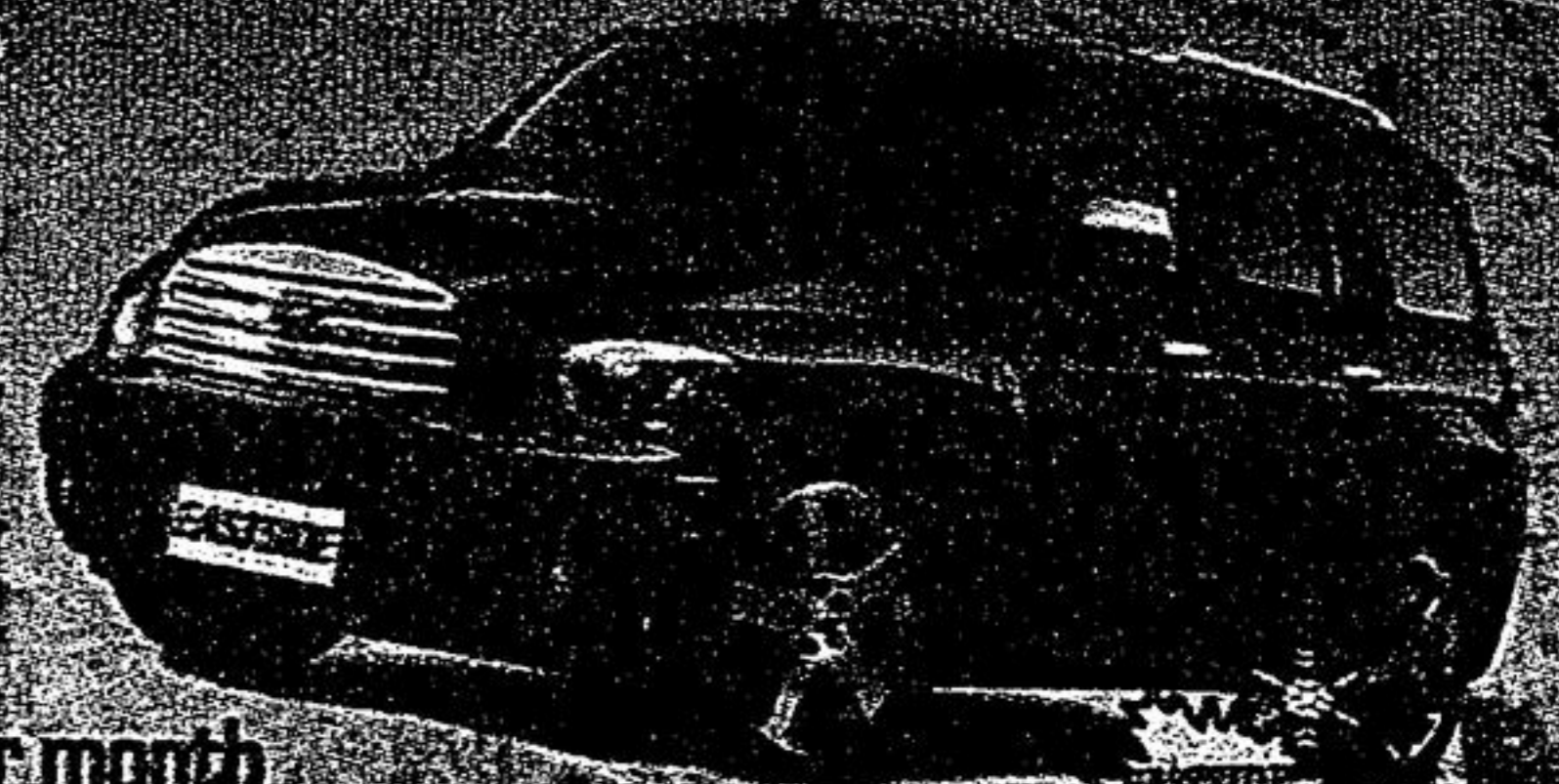

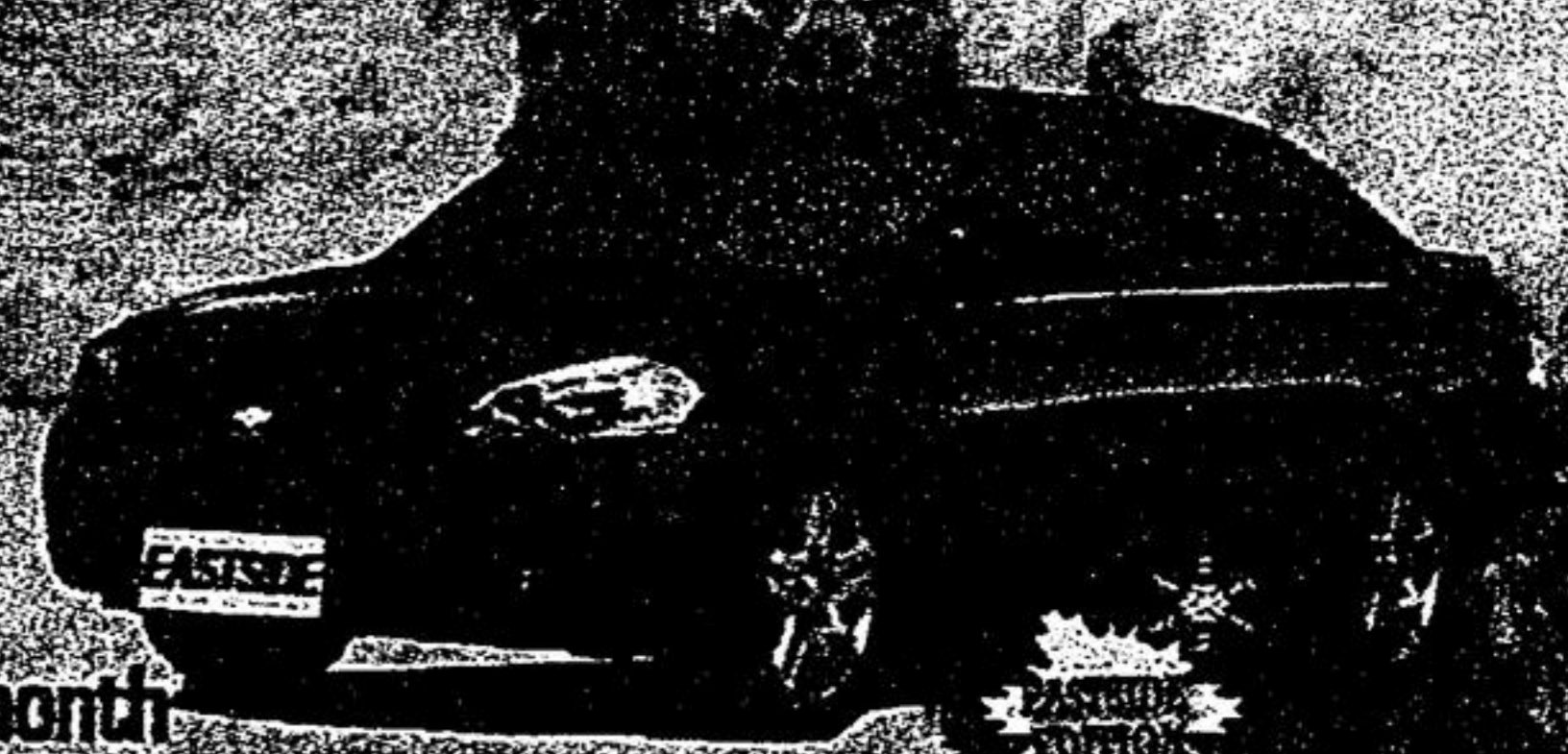
