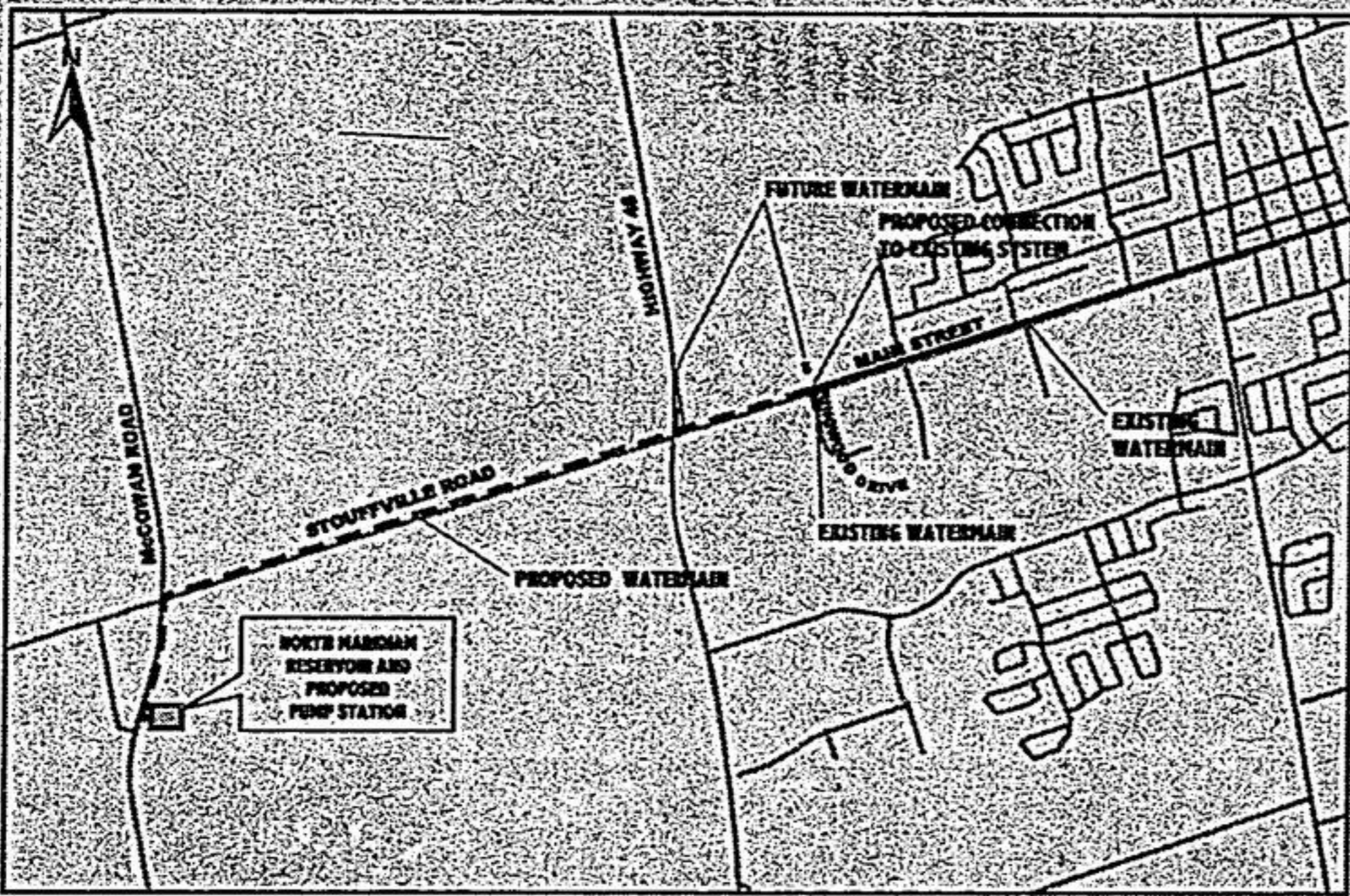
Water Supply for the Community of Stouffville Schedule B Class Environmental Assessment

NOTICE OF COMPLETION

The Regional Municipality of York has completed a Class Environmental Assessment (EA) study to determine a preferred source of new water supply and the preferred alternative for connecting the new supply to the existing system. The study is being undertaken to allow the Region to meet future water servicing requirements created by population and employment growth in the Community of Stouffville.

The preferred water supply alternative has been identified as a connection to the York Water System. Water will be supplied from the York Water System via the North Markham Reservoir (located on the east side of McCowan Road, south of Stouffville Road). Additional infrastructure improvements will include construction of a new pumping station to be located at the North Markham Reservoir site and a new watermain to be constructed along Stouffville Road from the pumping station to the existing distribution system at Ringwood Drive.

The study has been conducted in accordance with the requirements for Schedule B projects as described in the Municipal Engineers Association's *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* document (June 2000). Public Information Centres were held on September 17, 2003 and on January 25, 2006, three information bulletins were distributed to potentially affected residents and interested parties, and a Schedule B Environmental Assessment Report has been prepared. The EA Report describes the problem, the assessment of alternatives, the preferred alternative and mitigation and monitoring measures, as well as the public and agency consultation program. This Notice places the EA Report on public record for the mandatory 30-day review period. Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice and receipt of necessary approvals, York Region intends to proceed with design and construction of the proposed infrastructure.

Interested parties should provide written comments to Ms. Theresa MacIntyre, Project Manager, York Region Transportation and Works Department and/or to Mr. Stan Holden, Project Manager, MacViro Consultants Inc., by April 10, 2006.

If concerns arise regarding this project that cannot be resolved in discussions with the Region, a person/party may request that the Minister of the Environment make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred to as a "Part II Order"), which addresses individual environmental assessments. The Minister must receive requests, at the address below, for Part II Orders by April 10, 2006.

York Regional Police have arrested two people after they found video gambling machines at a Vaughan convenience store.
