Grim tale of debauchery

Starring Johnny Depp, John Malkovich, Rosamund Pike and Samantha Morton

This is a grim little tale concerning the debauched life and death of John Wilmot, the Second Earl of Rochester, an alcoholic, syphilitic poet in the patronage of King Charles II.

It is around 1675-80, the final years of Rochester's short life.

Johnny Depp, always one for outrageous portrayals and costumes, is as arch as we've seen him as this unashamedly, proudly degenerate man.

Mr. Depp creates a stunning series of characterizations of the man over the course of a few years in an episodic freak show.

From youthful, confident and gorgeous to gross, he inhabits the character to the bone.

His popularity sprang from the witty, sexually graphic poetry, which he was happy to share

John Malkovich is King Charles, torn in his fascination with Rochester's pleasure-seeking ways and his responsibilities and appearance as king.

Rochester's wife, Elizabeth (Ms. Pike) can't bear further humiliation; she knows he has a harem of mistresses.

She comes to hate him for hurting her and for drinking

himself to death. She's torn because she loves him in spite of it all.

Rochester focuses on making a middling theatre rat (Samantha Morton) into London's finest actress.

He trains her and, against everything in his head, comes to love her. She is the first woman to reject him.

From there, Rochester's life goes horrendously astray and that's where the film picks up.

It's always interesting to witness a flawed artist with his power and influence made accountable.

Mr. Depp is a terrific actor, but the film misses the mark.

We've been hit over the head by the same messages dozens of times, and as far as doomed rock star-esque figures go, Rochester is really nothing new.

How about Jim Morrison, Kurt Cobain, Johnny Cash, Elvis Presley, Sid Vicious and the rest? Same story, different century.

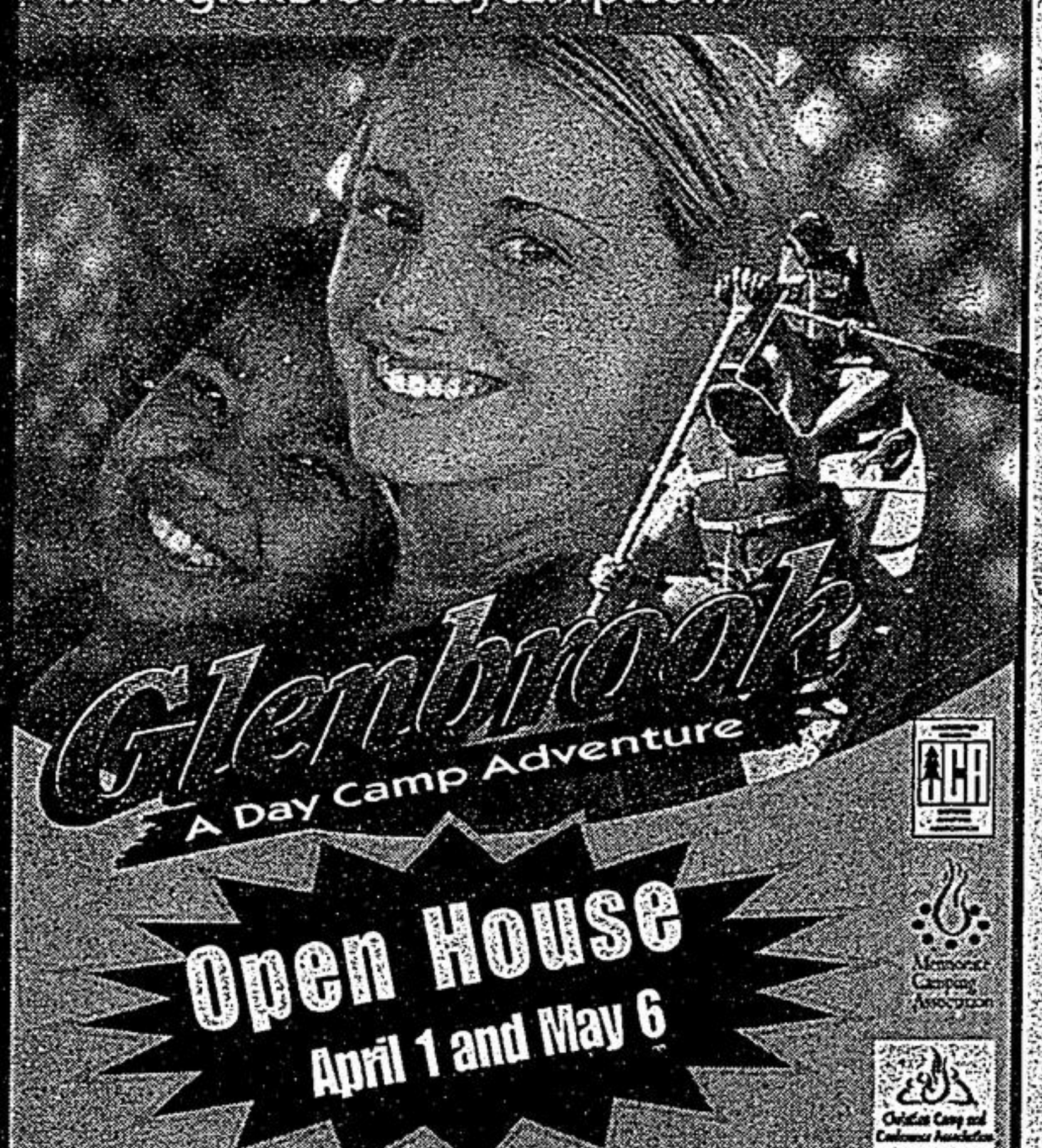
