PROJECT START-UP VANDORF-PRESTON LAKE SECONDARY PLAN

The Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville has re-initiated the Vandorf-Preston Lake Secondary Plan study process.

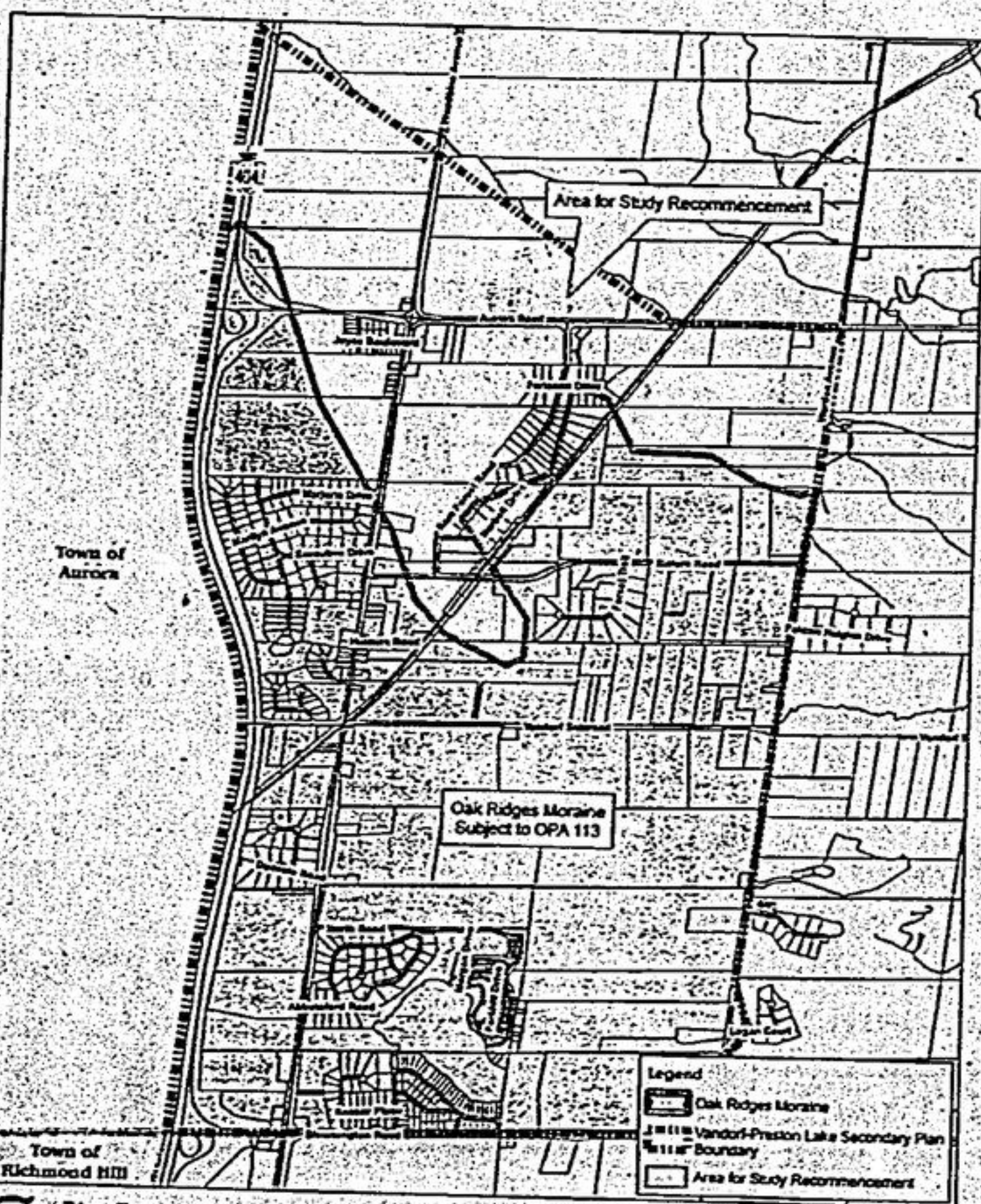
The attached Map outlines the Secondary Plan Study Area and the boundary of the Oak Ridges Moraine physiographic region.

In October 2003, Town Council adopted Official Plan Amendment #113 (OPA 113) which created land use designations and associated policies for those lands situated within the Vandorf-Preston Lake study area that are within the Moraine. Essentially, OPA 113 was a conformity exercise to bring these lands into compliance with the Province's Oak Ridges Moraine Conservation Plan. OPA 113 is still before the Province awaiting approval.

The commencement of the Secondary Plan Study will focus exclusively on those lands situated north of the Oak Ridges Moraine boundary in the vicinity of the intersection of Aurora Road and Woodbine Avenue. Analysis will focus on the need for and appropriateness of residential and employment land use activities for this district. Key elements of this analysis will include: the long term protection of environmentally sensitive lands; transportation networks; and, infrastructure (water / sewage) requirements and associated constraints.

Consultation with landowners and members of the Public remain a critical component of the Study process. A Public Information Session will be convened in late April 2006 so that members of the landowners and the Public are apprised of the various development options / scenarios being considered for this portion of the Secondary Plan Area. Future Notices will be issued advising of the date and location for the Public Information Session.
