

Boy, 4, injured in crash

A four-year-old boy was airlifted to Toronto's Hospital for Sick Children after the vehicle he was in rolled over during a serious collision Thursday.

The boy was travelling in a Nissan Sentra driven by a 25-year-old Georgina woman, when it collided with a minivan on Miles Road near Ravenshoe Road in Georgina shortly before 11:30 a.m.

Police said the collision

resulted from one of the vehicles failing to stop at an intersection.

The minivan struck the passenger side of the Nissan, causing it to roll over.

The minivan driver, a 46-year-old Toronto man and the passenger, a 57-year-old

Markham woman, suffered minor injuries.

The driver of the Nissan was treated at Southlake Regional Health Centre in Newmarket for minor injuries.

Officers are continuing their investigation.

York Regional Police announced the province has increased its speeding fines, which took effect March 31.

Now, if you are busted for travelling 30 kilometres per hour over the speed limit, you will be paying out \$180, up almost \$70 from the previous fine.

Fines for speeding through construction zones have also gone up, double in some instances.

Here is a quick glance at what the new speeding fines will be:

• 10 km/h: \$25;

• 15 km/h: \$37.50;

• 20 km/h: \$75;

• 30 km/h: \$180;

• 35 km/h: \$210;

• 40 km/h: \$270;

• 45 km/h: \$294 and;

• 50-plus: No set fine, court appearance.

For construction zones:

• 10 km/h: \$50;

• 15 km/h: \$75;

• 20 km/h: \$150;

• 25 km/h: \$187.50

• 29 km/h: \$217.50

• 30-plus: No set fine, court appearance.

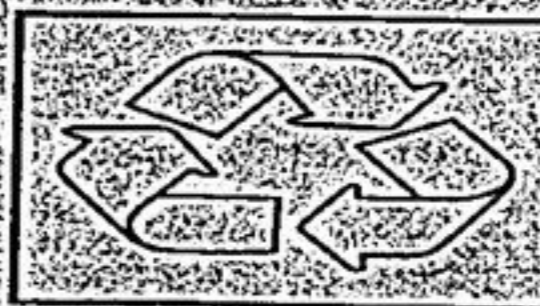
