

BMO robber gets 6 years in jail

A bank robber will spend the next six years behind bars after pleading guilty to four York Region heists last year.

In each incident, the man walked into the branch, approached a teller and demanded money. During two of the robberies he told the teller he had a gun.

The first took place Aug. 5 at a Bank of Montreal branch on Major Mackenzie Drive in Vaughan.

It was followed by robberies at a Newmarket bank Aug. 8, a Richmond Hill bank Oct. 5 and Stouffville's Bank of Montreal branch Oct. 12.

Peel Police caught up with the man Oct. 13 in connection with two convenience store robberies in Peel Region in May and September of 2005.

He was later connected to the York bank robberies and charged.

Dudley Knolton Peyton, 25, pleaded guilty to four counts of robbery and four counts of wearing a disguise in Newmarket court Thursday and was sentenced to six years in prison.

He also pleaded guilty to the two Peel Region incidents.

Markham teenager stabbed at home

A 15-year-old Markham boy is in stable condition in a Toronto hospital after being stabbed in the back during an altercation with a neighbour Saturday.

The boy was working on his motorcycle inside the garage of his family's Graham Crescent home, when a man came over waving a knife.

The boy tried to disarm him, but was cut on the leg and stabbed twice in the back, puncturing his lung, police said.

The boy fled to a home on nearby Raymerville Road and police were called. York officers responded and the street was blocked off.

A man, who neighbours say has a history of mental illness, surrendered to police.

A 32-year-old Markham man faces aggravated assault and weapons charges.
