It took about a year to create the first two attractions 15 years ago, drawing almost 2,000 visitors. Now the Magic Hill Haunted Adventure has

grown to five attractions, including The Barn, The Murder Mystery and the Black Cavern, which are indoors, and the Haunted Hayride and Terror Trail.

At least 2,000 visitors now come each night on October weekends. This year, The Haunted Adventure, which is spread throughout the 100-acre farm, will run over four weekends.
