Notice of Completion CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT YORK/DURHAM LINE (Y.R. 30) PROJECT Town of Markham

The Regional Municipality of York has completed a Class Environmental Assessment for the widening of York/Durham Line between Steeles Avenue and Highway 7.

The study has been conducted in accordance with schedule C of the *Municipal Class Environmental Assessment* (June 2000) under the *Ontario Environmental Assessment Act*.

Subject to the comments received as a result of this Notice and the receipt of other approvals as necessary, The Regional Municipality of York intends to proceed with the detailed design and construction of this project.

The purpose of this project is to widen the section of the York/Durham Line from Steeles Avenue to Highway 7 to four lanes to provide sufficient capacity for future traffic growth. Additional turning lanes will be provided at major intersections.

A Schedule C Environmental Study Report has been prepared for this project. The report describes the problem, the assessment of alternatives and the preferred solution, as well as the public and agency consultation program conducted during the Study.
