Big night for NHL hopefuls

They say that hope springs eternal. Several York Region minor hockey players hope their names will be called today by an NHL club at the annual draft in Vancouver.

According to the Central Scouting Bureau's final draft rankings in April, Stouffville's Bobby Hughes could go in the first round.

A second-year member of the Kingston Frontenacs of the Ontario Hockey League, the six-foot, 180-pound centre was rated as the 25th.

Playing in 56 regular season games this season, Hughes had 35 goals and 40 assists.

Rated as the 51st top North American prospect and a potential second round pick was Markham resident John Armstrong.

A six-foot, three-inch, 190-lb. forward with the Plymouth Whalers of the OHL, Armstrong amassed 14 goals and 23 assists in 65 regular season contests. In 13 post-season tilts, he had four goals and seven assists.

The top defenceman among York Region prospects was John deGray.

A six-foot, four-inch, 202-lb. second-year member of the Brampton Battalion of the OHL, deGray was ranked as the 68th top North American prospect. With

the Battalion this past year, deGray had 10 assists in 68 regular season contests.

Armstrong and deGray were former Markville Secondary School students and were teammates on the Canadian team that won gold at the Under-18 World Junior Cup last year in Piešťana, Slovakia.

Ranked 71st and a potential third-round pick was Holland Landing resident Harrison Reed.

A forward with the Sarnia Sting of the OHL, Reed had 26 goals and 24 assists in 68 games.

Newmarket resident James DeLory was the second York Region defenceman on the list. He ranks 73rd position and is a potential third-round pick. The six-foot, five-inch, 212-lb. DeLory played this past season with the Oshawa Generals of the OHL and had six goals and 26 assists in 67 regular season tilts.

The top York Region prospect among Provincial Junior A Hockey League players was Newmarket Hurricanes' forward David McIntyre.

Listed as the 88th top North American player, the Pefferlaw native led the Hurricanes in scoring this season with 42 goals and 50 assists in 46 games.

Following McIntyre was Vaughan Vipers' forward Matt Martello at 131st and a potential fifth-round pick.

Amassing 28 goals and 39 assists in 48 games with the Vipers, Martello was named the South Conference's most improved player and earned a scholarship to attend Lake Superior State University in Sault Ste-Marie, Mich. this fall.

Simon Gysbers was rated as the top York Region Provincial Junior A Hockey League defenceman at 153rd.

A third-year veteran with the Spirit, the six-foot, four-inch, 195-lb. Oak Ridges native had eight goals and 24 assists in 46 regular season contests. Like Martello, Gysbers will be attending Lake Superior State University this fall on a scholarship.
