

Storm ride Brown's arm to 10-6 win over Pt. Perry

Kerrick Brown struck out 11 out of 13 batters he faced in four and a half innings while Kevin Matthews, a call-up from the junior mites, belted a home run that to lift the Stouffville Storm mites to a 10-6 win over visiting Port Perry in Durham York Softball League action.
