expand at its new 10-acre property on the northwest corner of Woodbine Avenue and Stouffville Road.

The company, noted for its blue trucks, has more than 90 trucks and employs 115 people to haul oversized materials and equipment to construction sites throughout much of Ontario.

Ringwood Drive will be extended north of Main between the Anderson property and plaza to the west anchored by Patti-Lynn Interiors and will eventually connect to Millard Street.

Once the shopping centres are complete, more dollars will be spent in the municipality, Mayor Sue Sherban said.

Shoppers won't be as likely to leave the municipality if they have enough choice of retail businesses and shops here.

Representatives for both centres are signing up tenants,

shoppers from surrounding municipalities.

Stouffville's downtown will benefit as well, she said. Once they're in the area, people will head to the quieter downtown area for its restaurants and specialty shops. Because of these two developments, the building of roads such as Hoover Park Drive and the extension of Millard Street is being pushed forward.

Once Millard is complete, drivers will be able to take it to Main Street in the west end without cutting through subdivisions.

"Rupert Avenue will see a huge reduction of their traffic due to the opening of Millard Street," Ms. Sherban said.

Part of the Anderson Haulage property is being developed for a residential subdivision which will abut homes on Sandale Avenue north of Tim Hortons.

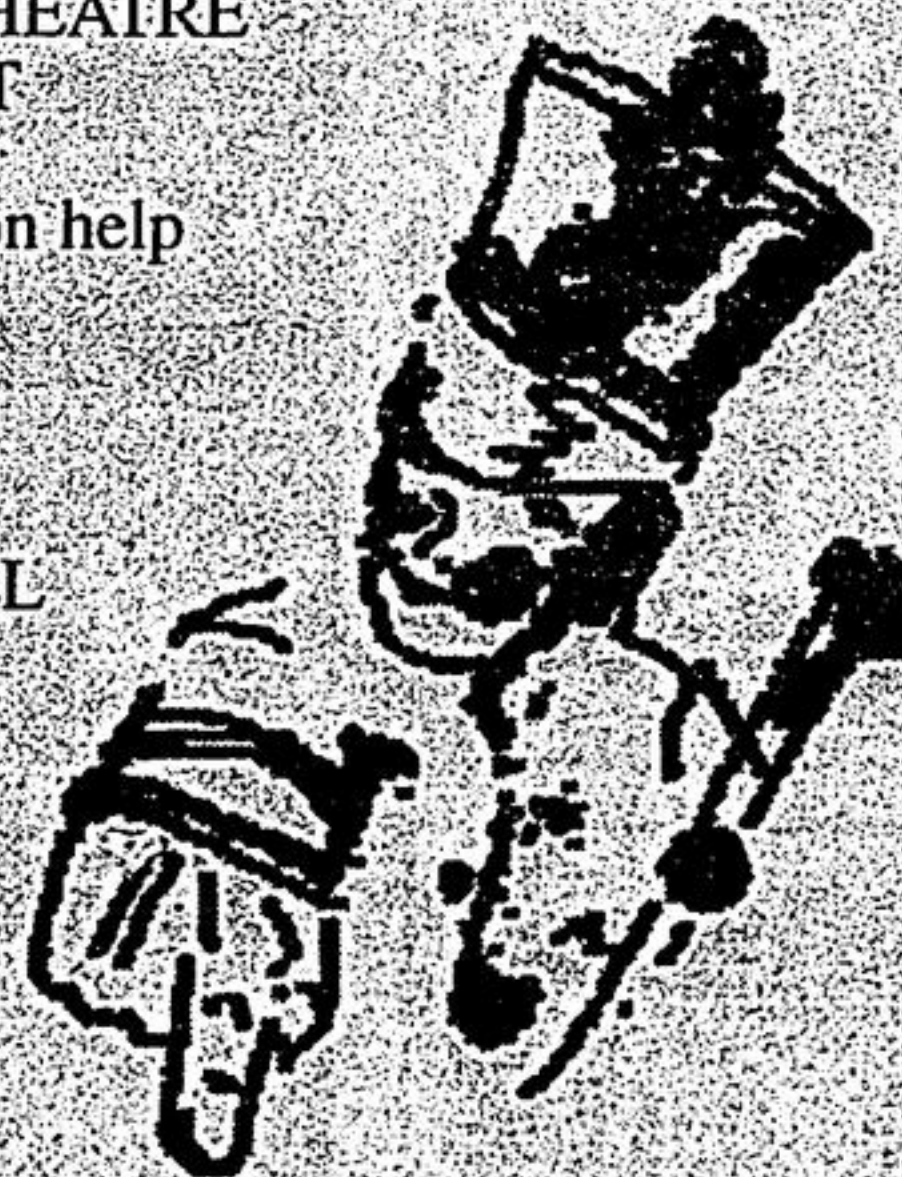
