

Public won't see full incineration list

You won't be able to see a long list of potential sites for a York-Durham incineration facility.

Instead, the region will present a short list of five or six sites in February and submit their final selection for approval by the Environment Ministry next September.

"The schedule is now being driven by the closure of the Michigan border," York Region waste management director Andy Campbell said at a meeting Tuesday in Vaughan.

York will be out of Michigan by 2008, sending your trash to a Vaughan facility that will convert it to pellets and will divert the

rest through green bin programs.

That said, the partnership with Durham means York is subject to a push by Durham to get the facility up and running, Mr. Campbell noted.

Durham has a more immediate need for an energy-from-waste facility because the 2010 closure of the Michigan border to GTA trash, leaves it with no alternative.

The tight deadline means the region won't publicize the full list of sites being considered, making the selection process less transparent. However, creating a long list of potential sites may just create unnecessary concern, Mr. Campbell added.

"As soon as you put an X on a map, it creates a lot of stress for

people," he said.

The long list has little public value because it could contain sites that haven't been eliminated, but make no sense for the energy-from-waste facility, he said.

One major criteria is proximity to a user such as a large automotive manufacturing plant that can use the steam energy created by facility.

Other factors include proximity to major highways and the distance garbage will have to travel.

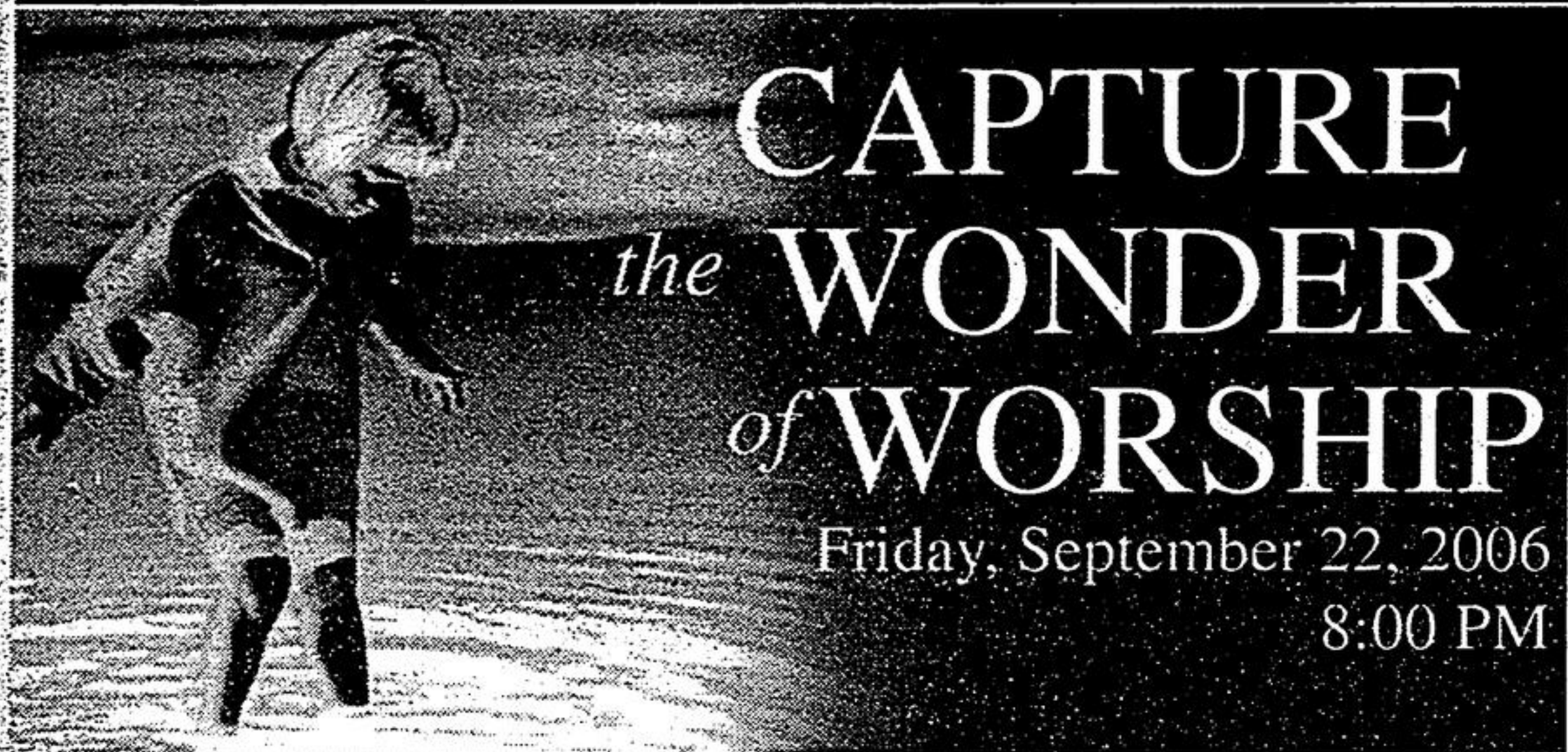

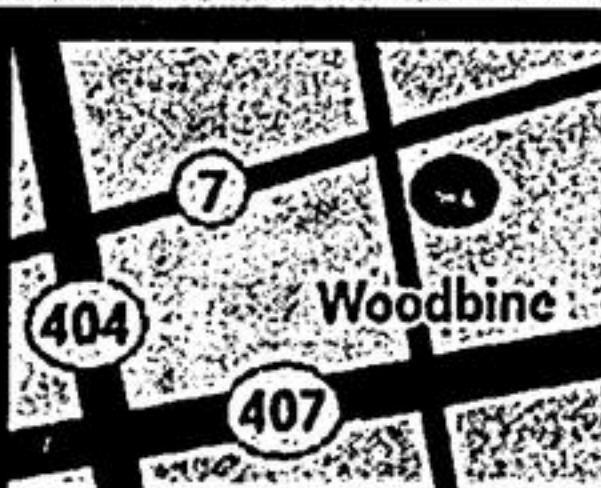
