### WATER DISTRIBUTION FLUSHING PROGRAM

#### COMMUNITIES OF BALLANTRAE & MUSSELMAN LAKE

The Public Works Department reminds residents that it routinely conducts watermain flushing operations of the Ballantrae/Musselman Lake municipal water distribution system.

The next flushing of the system is scheduled to resume on Monday October 23rd, 2006. The work takes place between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., and is generally repeated every four (4) weeks.

This flushing is necessary to simulate normal operation of the system.

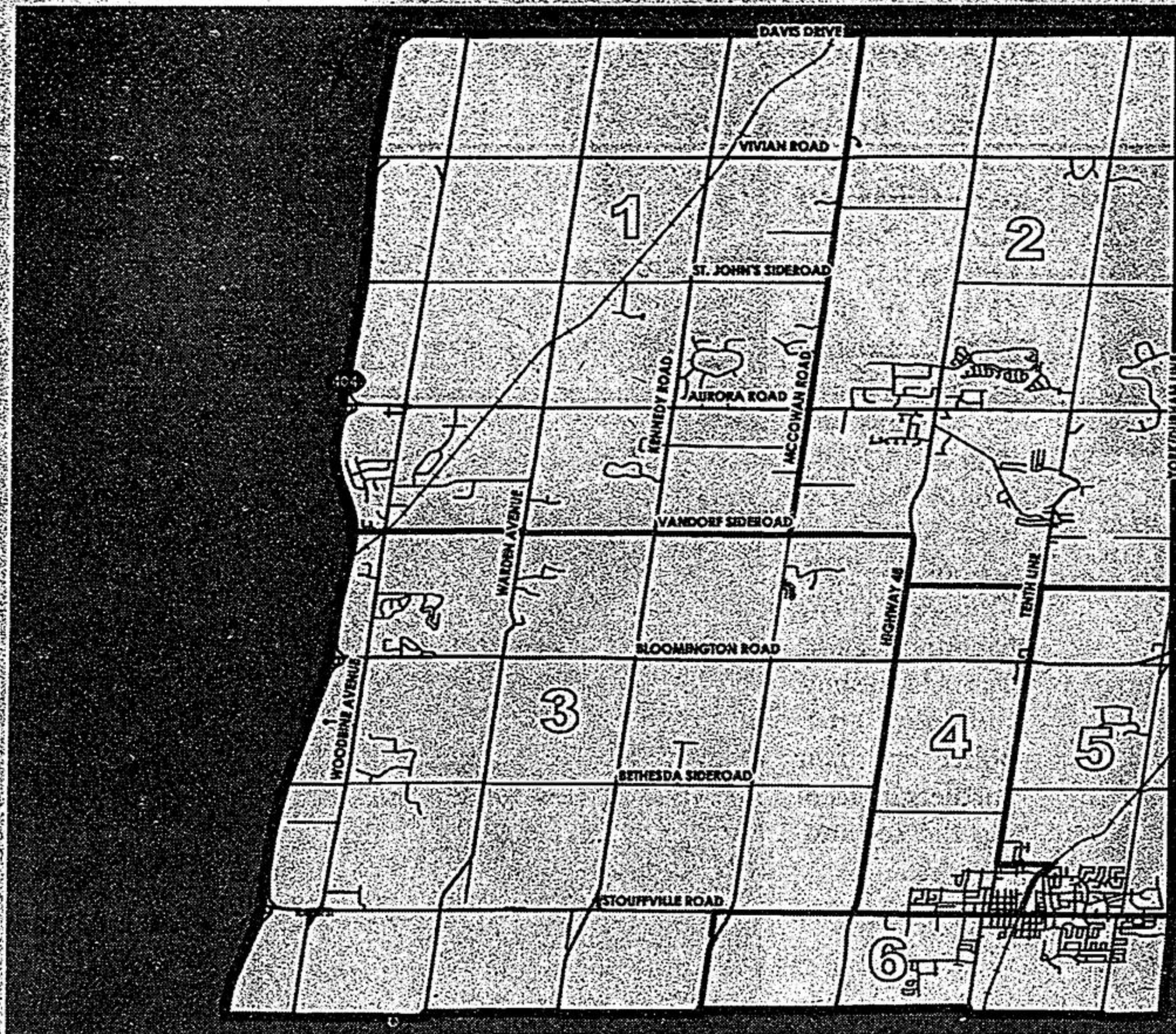
#### COMMUNITY OF STOUFFVILLE

The Public Works Department will be conducting a watermain flushing program throughout the Community of Stouffville, commencing Monday October 23rd, 2006. This work will be conducted between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. and is expected to last until approximately Friday November 17th, 2006.

During the flushing operation discolouration of the water may occur and because of this we ask for your assistance by restricting the use of water to a minimum while the work is being conducted. Should discolouration of the water occur, let water run until it clears.

## MUNICIPAL ELECTION INFORMATION

Voting Day: Monday, November 13, 10 a.m. - 8 p.m.

### Who may vote?

Any person who on November 13th 2006 meets the following qualifications is eligible to vote.

1. Is a Canadian citizen;
2. Is at least 18 years of age;
3. Resides in the municipality or is the owner, tenant, or spouse of the owner or tenant of land; and
4. Any person not prohibited, by law from voting.

Please note corporations are not entitled to vote.

### Advance Voting Days

Electors are encouraged to vote early and avoid line-ups at any one of the following advanced voting places, regardless of the Ward you reside in:

**Where and when do eligible electors vote on Voting Day?**

### How to add your name to the Voters' List

To add your name to the Voters' List, you are required to complete an Application to Amend the Voters' List, available in person at the Clerk's Department, by mail or online, as indicated above. If your application is not submitted by November 8, you will be required to attend the voting place on Voting Day. Please bring current government-issued identification with you when you vote.

### Where do university or college students vote?

Students can vote either at home or in the municipality in which they attend school.

### Municipal Election Candidates

On Monday, November 13, 2006, eligible electors in the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville will elect municipal council representatives to serve a four-year term. In addition, French Public (le Conseil scolaire de district du Centre-Sud-Ouest) electors will also be casting their ballot to elect a trustee.
