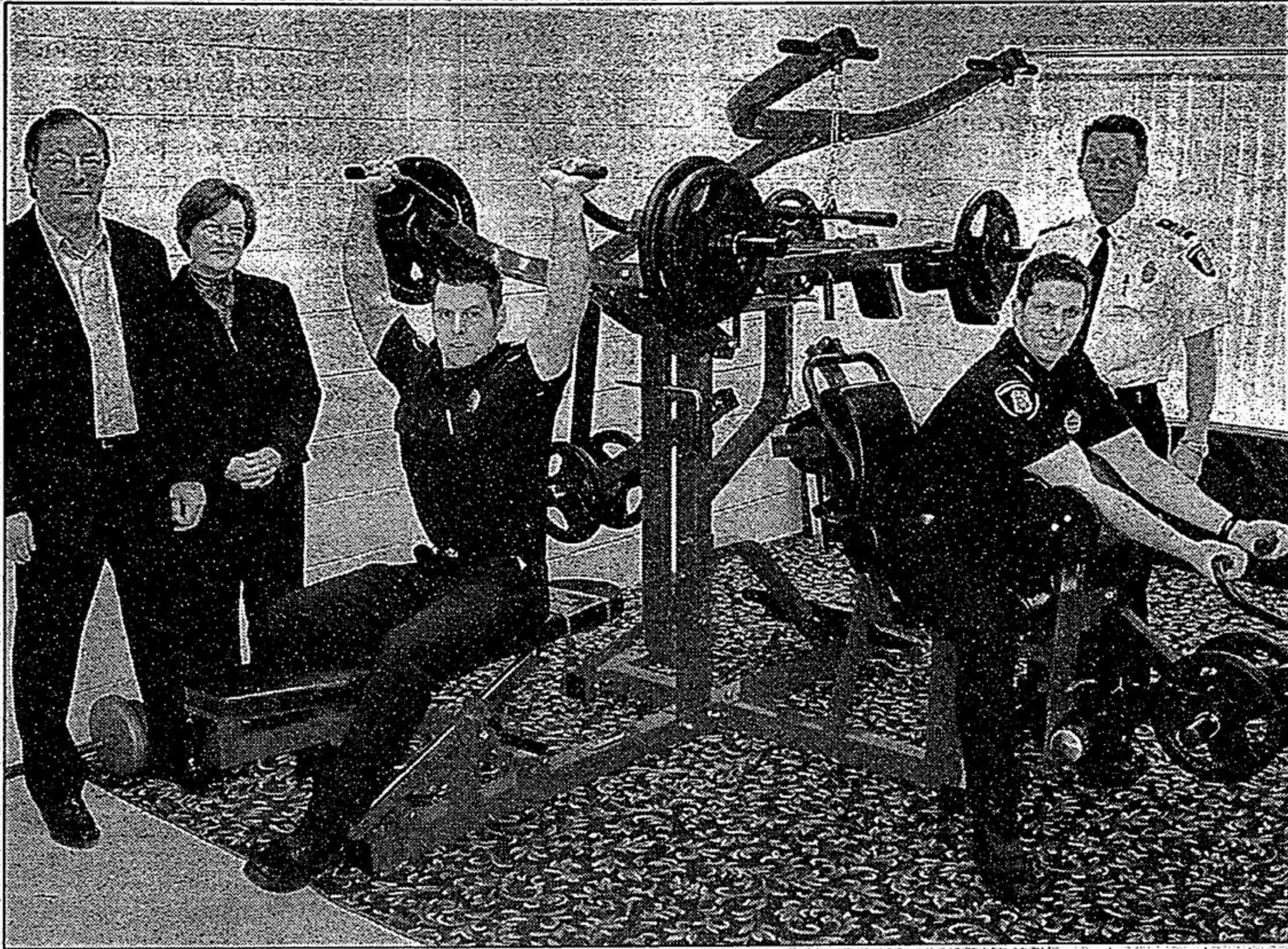


FIREFIGHTERS ARMED WITH NEW EQUIPMENT

WhiSteradio is a community station heard over the Internet. Its shows include live Stouffville Spirit hockey broadcasts and municipal election features.

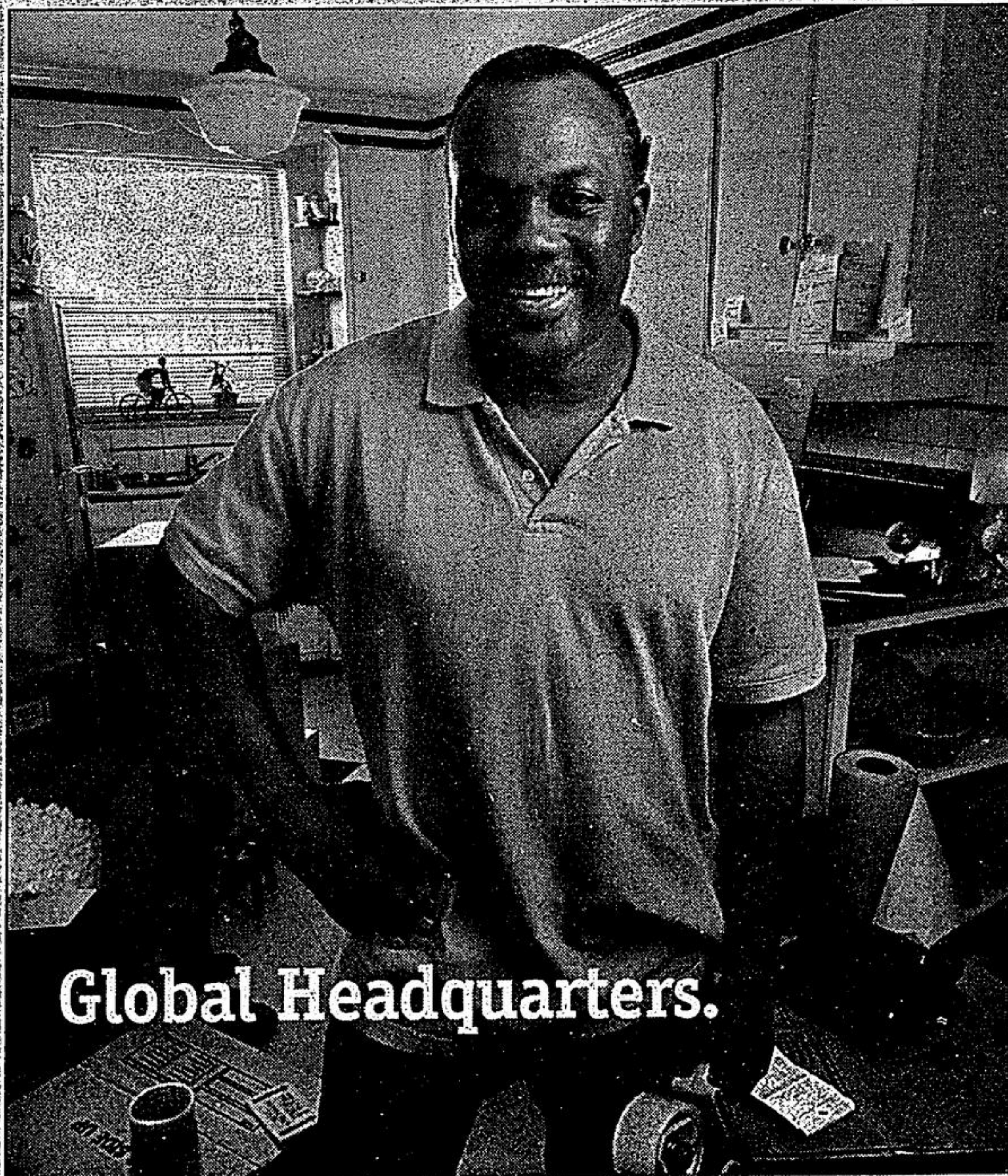

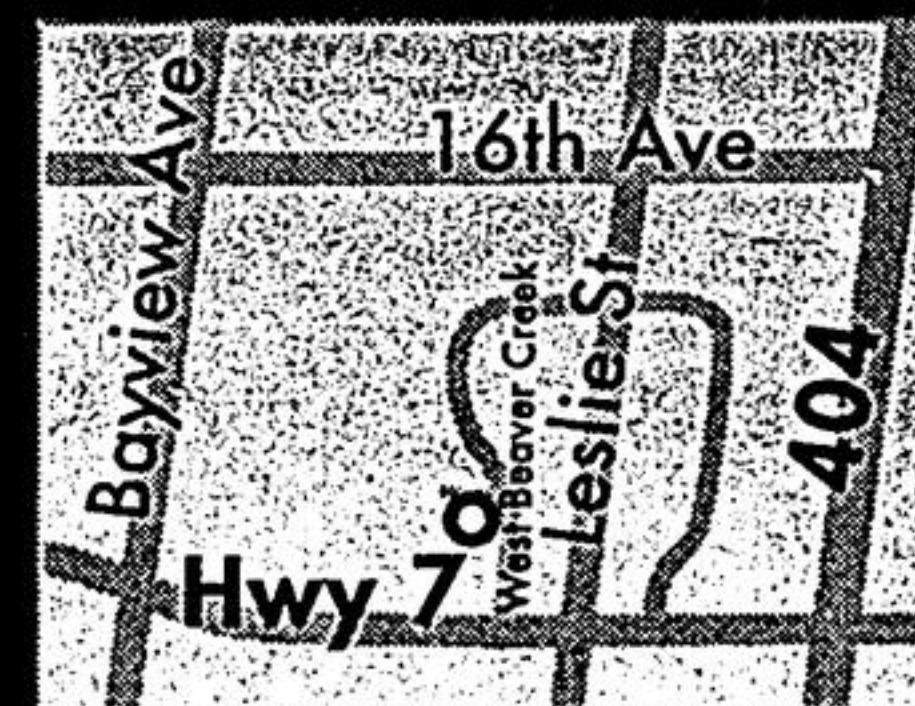
