Little brother makes like Mike

The names Sullivan and the Stouffville Spirit have been linked to some high-scoring exploits.

Mike Sullivan had 61 points in 49 games during his only season with the Provincial Jr. A Hockey League team, 2002-03. Drafted after that season by the NHL's Los Angeles Kings, he's now a senior on scholarship at Clarkson University in Potsdam, N.Y.

On Thursday night at the Stouffville Arena it was his younger brother Mark leading the Spirit (14-8-1-2) to a 6-1 win over the Huntsville Muskoka Otters.

Mark had two goals and two assists. "Mike would have had the had trick," Mark, a Stouffville minor hockey product, quipped in a happy Spirit dressing room.

Joel Sheppard had the game winner, with Corey Trivino, Will Acton and Mike Foy adding singles.

Donivan Munro, Ryan Oliver and Randy Johnston had two assist nights.

The score didn't represent the game. Huntsville, which scored first, trailed 2-1 midway through the third period but could not beat Spirit netminder Mark Kubicz on three glorious chances. The Spirit then countered with three goals in 2:03 and added another in the dying minutes.

"It's nice to make the big save and then see the guys reward it at the other end," said Kubicz, the former Ontario Hockey Leaguer with the St. Mike's Majors.
