YRT TO INTRODUCE NEW FARES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 2007 - NEWMARKET

York Regional Council has approved increases for select York Region Transit (YRT) fares, effective January 2007. The fare increases are expected to generate an additional \$2 million in revenue to help offset the Region's estimated \$75 million in annual transit program costs.

The approved YRT fare changes take into account a number of different factors, including current service contractor rates, gas prices, consistency with other GTA transit system fare structures, cost recovery targets and the opportunity to discount fares for regular transit customers.

The proposed fare increases will not affect the following categories: Student tickets, Senior/Child tickets, Ride to GO tickets and the Ride to GO Monthly Sticker Pass.

THE STUDY:

URS Canada Inc. has been retained by the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville to undertake a study for the McCowan Road Reconstruction from Bloomington Road to Aurora Road.
