Regardless of the recent turmoil, Mrs. Cavanagh believes her son is being helped by working on the keychains. That's the most impor-

tant thing.

"I've always supported the red ribbon campaign, but aside from that, it was always just another charity," she said. "They do phenomenal work."

OPP reports from the night Mr. Fockler died show he was thrown from a vehicle that went off Hwy. 48 in Georgina.

On the front, a note handwritten by Eric pleads, "Think about it. I miss my uncle Joey every day. E.B."

Ms Cavanagh said the family got involved with MADD Canada after she contacted them looking for advice and counselling.

"(Eric) decided he wanted to do something," she said.

"He keeps saying, 'I just want my

grandma and grandpa to smile."

The tragedy has shaken the family, she added.
