Musselman Lake area will begin, Mr. Bannon said.

Currently, it's a regional responsibility.

"We have to determine if we want ownership of that road," he said. "It's easy to say we're going to take control of this road, but there are so many concerns we have to take into account."

One of them is money.

"Do we have the wherewithal to support this financially?" he said.

The final vision, according to Mr. Bannon, is for the area to become a boulevard community.

Doug Grensted, whose family has lived in the lake area for more than 50 years, said he is not opposed to the idea of increasing safety in the community, but doesn't feel like he is at risk when out on the roads.

"I don't think it's anything that

needs a great deal of work," he said.

Lake resident Alexandra Heilbron pointed to a hill on Ninth Line south of the lake that drops down toward the lake as dangerous.

"They just come speeding up and over it," she said.

Another potential issue is drivers exceeding the limit unaware children may be running back and forth across the road to a convenience store serving the community, she said.

Ultimately, local drivers have a major role to play in the safety of the community, Councillor Bannon said.

"In most cases it's the residents who are speeding," he said. "They have to set a good example in the community."
