

Spirit opens post-season Thursday, but with who?

The Stouffville Spirit pulled out another win at the Stouffville Arena Thursday.

Good enough for the regular season, but not for the playoffs that loom so large, James McIntosh says.

The Spirit stumbled through the first period, before dumping the Orangeville Crushers 3-1.

"We can't start like that in the playoffs," said, McIntosh, a second-year winger from Holland Landing. "We have to come to the rink prepared and focused, with everyone rolling."

The playoffs open next Thursday in Stouffville. Likely first-round opponents include the Lindsay Muskies and Cobourg Cougars.

The Spirit (27-16-2-2) has sown up second place in the North Conference of the Provincial Jr. A Hockey League, the highest finish in team history. They are 9-

2-0-0 since the Christmas break.

McIntosh and Mark Sullivan had a goal and an assist each in the third period to break open what was a 1-1 tie. The Spirit was without several regulars due to injuries and a suspension.

Orangeville led 1-0 after one.

Donovan Munro scored the only goal of the second on a Spirit power play.

Trevor O'Neill held the Spirit in, especially in the first. The Spirit outshot the Crushers 42-25.

McIntosh and O'Neill shared Farmer Jack's player of the game honours.

The same teams met last night in Orangeville. The Spirit ends the regular season Monday night at Vaughan.

The Spirit is defending North Conference and North-West champions.


