## COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

### SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING NINETEEN ON THE PARK!

At their February 27 special meeting, Council selected the architectural firm of Taylor Hazell Architects to prepare plans for the redevelopment of 19 Civic Avenue, known as the concept name *Nineteen on the Park!* The building will serve as a multi-purpose event centre with flexible programming space for arts, cultural and community activities.

The design concept is anticipated to be presented to Council in May or June of 2007 with the building renovation tender award scheduled to be made at Council's August, 2007 meeting. ### REVIEW OF PAID, STATUTORY COMMITTEES AND APPOINTEES OF COUNCIL

Council approved recommendations related to paid, statutory committees and appointees of Council, part of Council's governance review initiative. ### PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALK NINTH LINE AND SUNSET BOULEVARD

Council will request that the Region of York install traffic signals at the intersection of the Ninth Line and Sunset Boulevard as part of the Ninth Line Improvement Project. The request followed an analysis of methods of providing pedestrian crossing control to enhance safety.

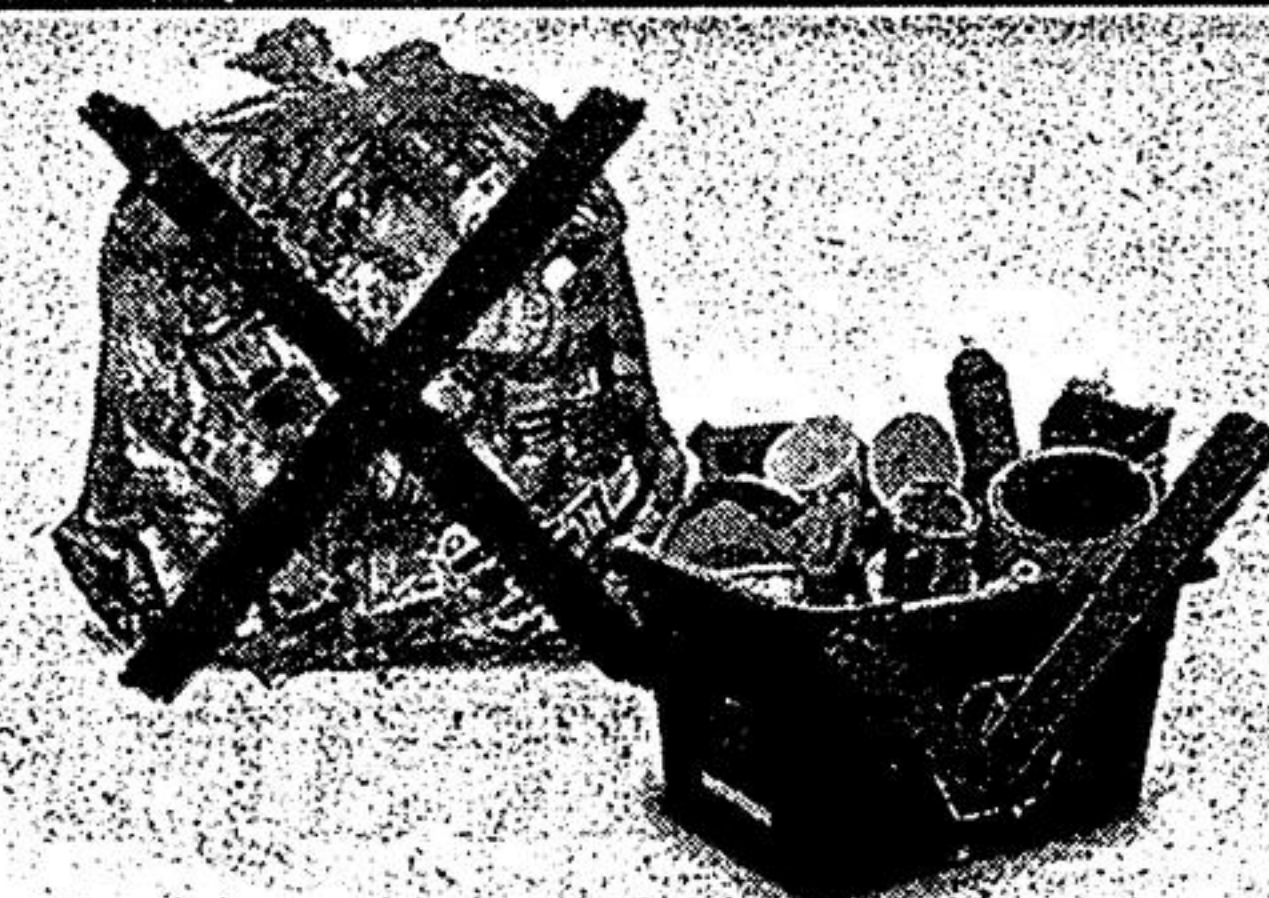
