Hulshof wins gold

Justin Hulshof was busy last weekend.

Taking to the ice for two teams in two events, Hulshof won gold as a member of the Richmond Hill Stars at the Ontario Minor Hockey Association AAA/Midget Championships in Markham.

A six-foot, four-inch tall forward, Hulshof helped his

club defeat the Oakville Rangers 3-2 in Sunday's championship final.

A Grade 11 student at Brother Andre Catholic High School, Hulshof also played for his school's senior boys hockey team at the provincial AAA/AAAA playdowns.

The Cardinals won bronze with a 6-3 win over Mayfield Secondary School (Caledon) in the consolation final.

Hughes apologizes

Bobby Hughes said he was sorry.

The Ontario Hockey League team accepted his apology and said an incident involving the 19-year-old Stouffville resident and the club's leading scorer was water under the bridge.

During Monday's first round playoff series against the Oshawa Generals, Hughes was frustrated at being benched for the final seven minutes of the third period in a game the Frontenacs lost 7-6 in overtime. With the win, the Generals took a 2-0 lead in the best-of-seven series.

Reports said Hughes, who led the club in scoring this

season and was 10th overall in the league with 40 goals and 56 assists in 59 games, removed his jersey in front of his teammates in the dressing room between the third period and overtime and told them he was through with the team.

But after discussions with team management, Hughes and the issue was resolved.

A fourth-round draft pick of the Carolina Hurricanes in last year's NHL draft, Hughes played in the third game. Kingston lost 7-4, but won 8-2 on Thursday to force a fifth game last night.

Hughes isn't the only Stouffville resident playing in the league's postseason. Playing for the Generals is rookie defenceman Michael Del Zotto.

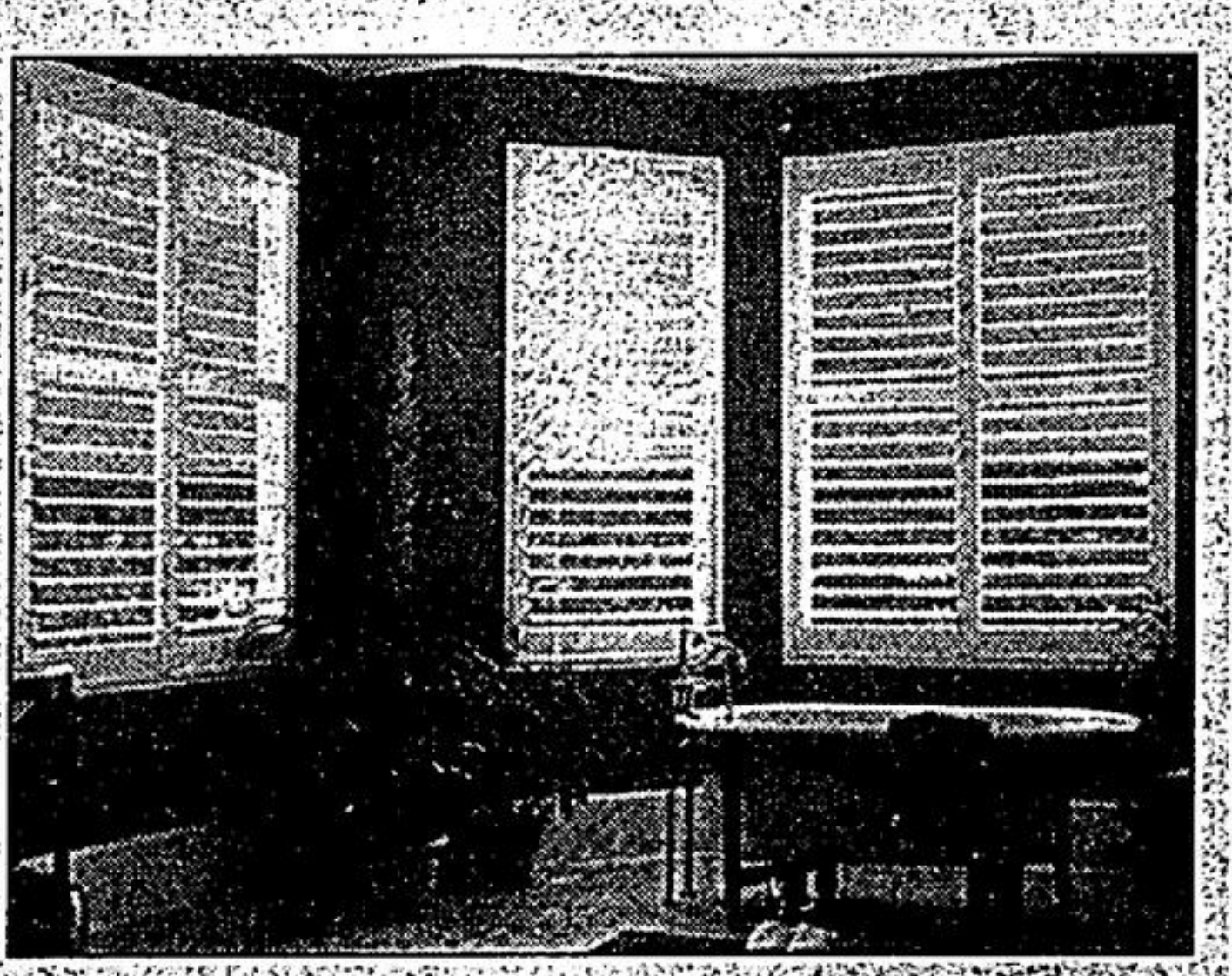
