

Burrows gets the Blues as new Collingwood GM

Ken Burrows wasn't out of work for long. Fired as general manager of the Stouffville Spirit 11 days ago, he accepted the same post with the rival Collingwood Blues Tuesday.

Both teams play in the North Conference of the Provincial Jr. A Hockey League. The Spirit has not announced replacements for Burrows and fired head coach Dan West.

"Kenny and I met a few weeks back when it was made public that he would no longer be with the Stouffville Spirit, (and) we continued to talk until (Tuesday) when he accepted the position," Blues chief operating officer Dan McIlhorne said.

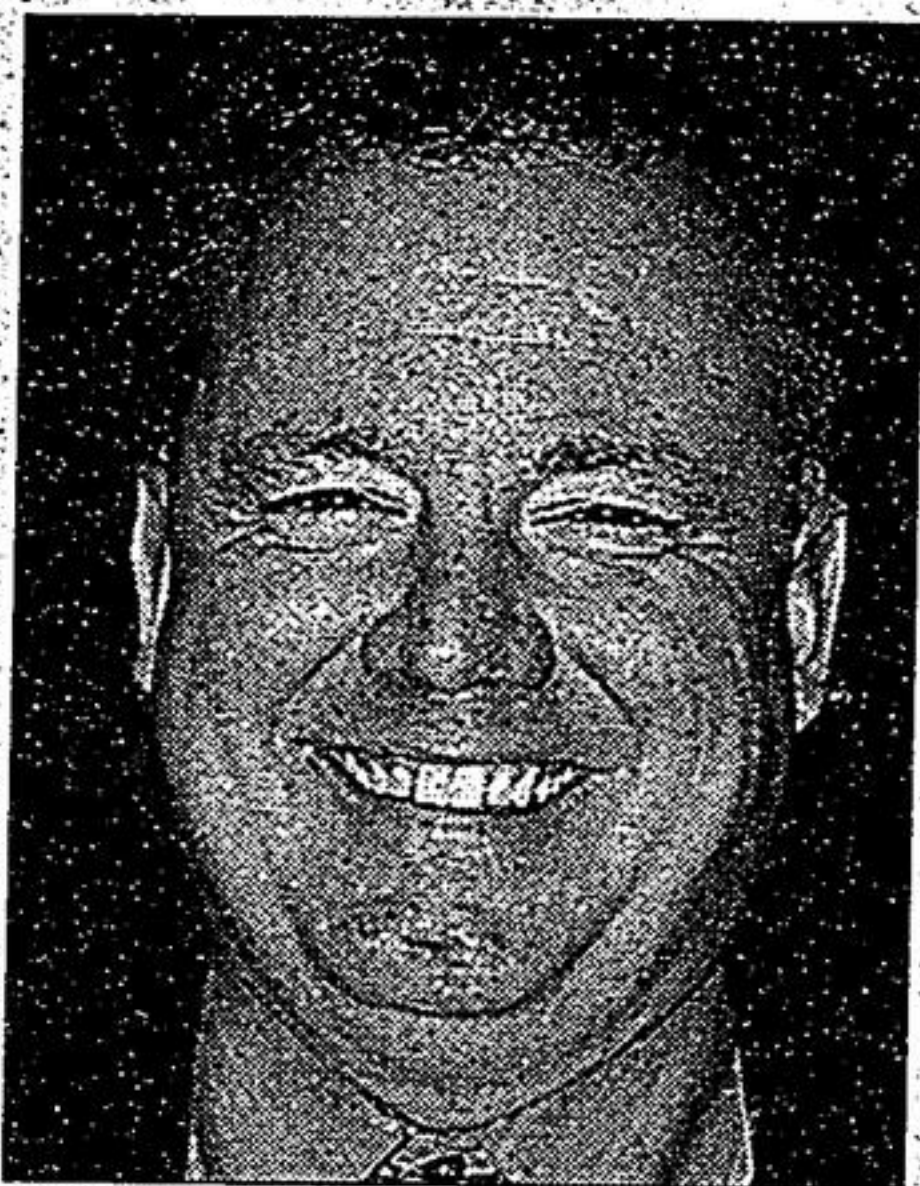
Burrows, a former minor hockey star in Stouffville, spent 11 years with the Spirit including the past six as general manager.

"In Collingwood, we have always respected the Spirit organization and feel that it was a great spot for kids to play and move on to the next level," McIlhorne said. "Their track record for sending kids on to the NCAA, OHL and being drafted into the NHL is excellent. Without a doubt, Ken was a big part of that success."

The Spirit won the North Conference and North West championships in 2006.

This past season, the Spirit was defeated by Aurora in the North final after disposing of the Blues in a four-game sweep.

"I have always enjoyed coming up to Collingwood to play and have always loved the Eddie Bush Arena," Burrows said. "The fans are amazing and I look for-

ward to being part of the Blues organization."

Assistant general manager Dale West remains with the Blues.

"I'm looking forward to having Ken join us," he said. "He has made the rivalry with Stouffville a fun one over the years, but I'm happier to have him working with us."

McIlhorne was also the Blues' general manager for the past three seasons.

"I will be more involved in the corporate side of the hockey club," said McIlhorne, who is also a scout for the Kingston Frontenacs of the Ontario Hockey League.

The Spirit holds its training camp May 5 and 6 at the Stouffville Arena.
