Council's new meeting schedule is now in place and applies to meetings of Council in Committee (CIC), Council and Public Hearing meetings.

- CIC will be held the first Tuesday of each month, 7 p.m.
- Council meetings will be held the third Tuesday of each month, 3 p.m.
- Public Hearing meetings will be held the third Tuesday of each month, 7 p.m., as required, following Council meetings.

CIC, Council and Public Hearing meetings are held in the Council Chamber, 4th floor, 37 Sandiford Drive, Stouffville.

CIC continues to be a more informal session of Council intended to discuss staff reports and allow for feedback from residents and other stakeholders. Council meets two weeks following CIC to consider CIC recommendations including any by-laws to be passed. Public Hearing meetings are held for Council to consider matters under the Planning Act and related statutes.

GREEN BIN COMING SOON!

In September, residents in the Town will transition to a new waste management system, which includes the introduction of a green bin used to separate household organic materials from recycling and garbage.

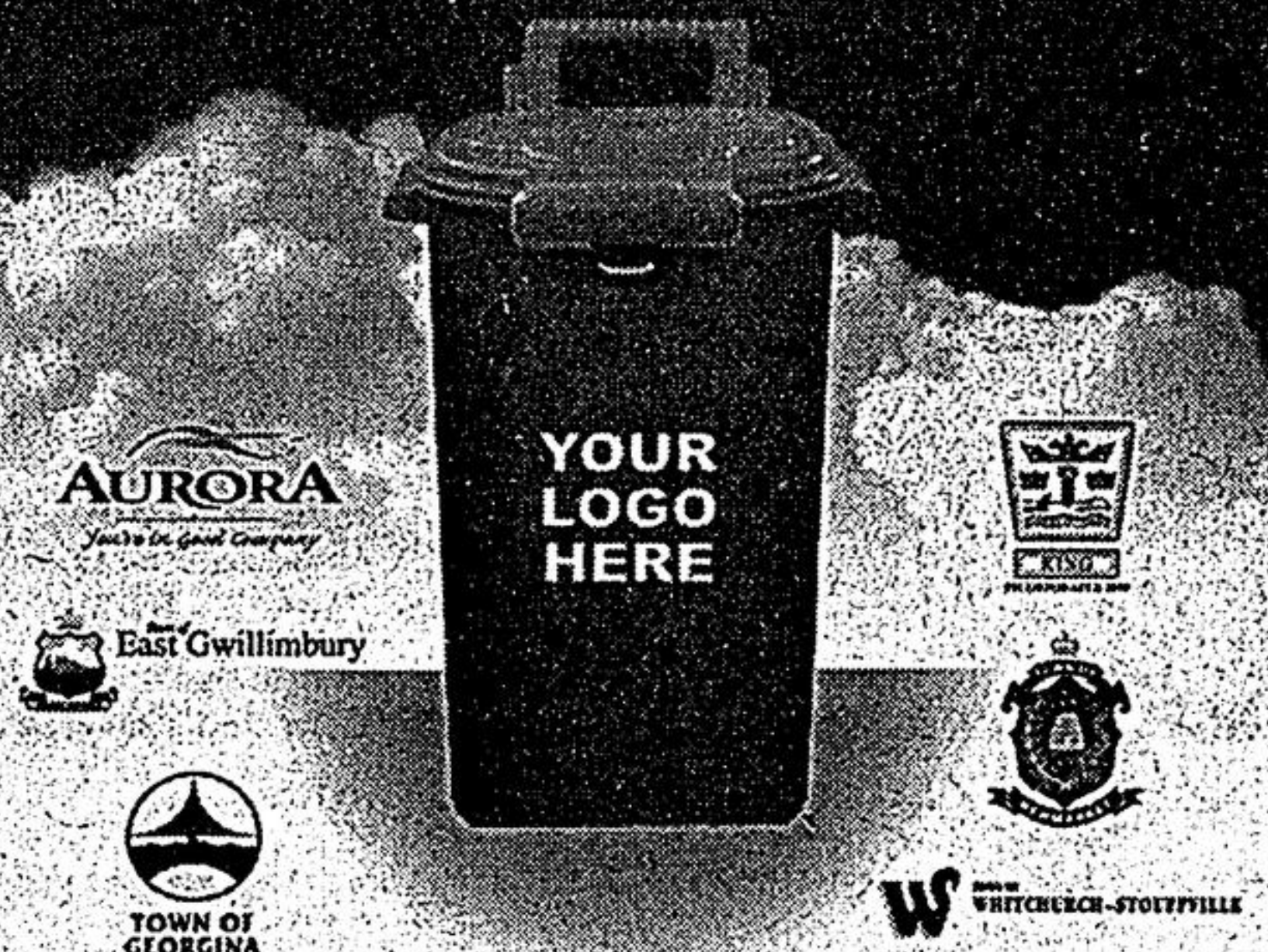
The goal of the new waste management program is to divert 65% of waste from landfill sites through the following means:

- Recycling 33%
- Green Bin 30%
- Yard Waste 5%
